Take 2 with PAUL POWER


Shame on me...I was going through my music files from the latter part of 2019 and saw this unopened album "Hill Of Beans" by someone who's name I didn't recognize. I opened the album and as soon as I heard the first sonq,

"Oxbow Lakes", I was amazed. Then I realized that Ralph McTell was the guy who wrote 2 of the most amazing songs I have ever "The heard: Of Streets London" in

1969-and the hauntingly beautiful, yet sorrowful "From Claire To Here", released in 1976 (the best version I've heard is actually done by our own Bruce Guthro) so of course I had a total "duh" moment. As I mentioned, this album was released late last year and it's been 9 years since Ralph's last one, so fans were eager to hear from him. McTell reunited with producer Tony Visconti, who provided the arrangements for McTell's first album in 1968, and as he approaches the age of 75 there's no sign of McTell even remotely watering down the quality of his music and lyrics. For instance. the album's namesake song actually pays homage to the Humphrey Bogart film "Casablanca", incorporating lines from the movie into the lyrics to make for a surprisingly good number that stands on its own merits. One would be hard-pressed to find a more meaningful life song than "When We Were Young", and "Sometimes I Wish I Could Pray" is so much like a Tom T. Hall number that

would perfectly at home in the 1970's. A big surprise here (amongst smaller surprises) Ralph's sona "Freewheelin' Bob Dylan", as Ralph waxes poetically McTELL about Bob and Suzy Rottollo's picture on the cover

of the Dylan record, the times (1963) and changes that inevitably come. It's true that quite a few people won't be familiar with who Ralph McTell is (although a lot are) but the fact that the man wrote songs that stand the test of time after 50 years is a testament to his ability to craft a tune, conversely I would take a bet that in 50 years time people will be saying "Taylor who?...Cardi What?", so grab onto McTell's songs. Overall, this is a very contemplative album loaded with meaningful songs that at times have sonic touches of Dire Straits, Tom T. Hall and Leonard Cohen-all of which prove just how good Ralph McTell's music really is.





TAX TIPS COLUMN

People new to Canada, immigrant, student, non residents. Tax deductions vary but here are some useful tips.

In Canada, residents are taxed based on their world income. Part-year residents must report all income from anywhere in the world after their arrival in Canada. New Canadians are entiled to the GST/HST credit after their arrival. If they quaify, the amount received is based on their world income for the preceding year.

If the new resident has investment income abroad, they may be required to notify the payers of their Canadian residency status. Certain tax treaties provide for a reduced rate of witholding in the originating country.

Moving Expenses to Canada are not deductible with one exception. If the immigrant is a student studying at a post-secondary level, moving expenses may be deducted against the taxable portion of any scholarships, bursaries, fellowships or reseach grants.

Personal amounts and dependent claims may have to be pro-rated depending on the period of residence in Canada.

Immigrants with children may qualify to begin receiving the Canada Child Benefits the month after they arrive depending on their immigration status. Form RC66 (Canada Child Benefits Application) and the related schedule should be completed shortly after arrival.

New Canadians who own capital property such as real estate and securities should determine its Fair Market Value (FMV) on the day they established residence. This constitutes the deemed cost for calculating any future capital gains and will ensure that when the property is sold they will only be taxed on the difference between the sale price and the value when they arrived in Canada.
