# Take 2

I wasn't actually planning on writing about this movie, but where it's the latest release in the "Terminator" franchise it warrants a literary look-plus I watched it last night so the impressions left with me are

still fresh; this movie serves as a follow-up to the second "Terminator 2: Judgment Day", and it's great to see Linda Hamilton and Arnold Schwarzenegger reprising their roles 28 years after the original movie, as well as James Cameron being onboard as co-producer. To

be honest the first 10 minutes of "Terminator; Dark Fate" had me less than enthusiastic because it was like a 'Michael Bay on steroids' cluster bomb of CGI action (but some people like that) and I did not like the new Terminator "Rev 9", (played by Gabriel Luna) because it's hunter/killer skills were just too over the top, relentless, slightly annoying and reminiscent of the Spider Man movie character Venom's superpowers (you'll know what I mean when you see them here). Luckily enough the story line soon moved back to being just that-a story reuniting 2 deadly enemies-forced to fight a new common foe, and protect the future of the human race, but in a very different and interesting way than before; it's the chemistry between Sarah Connor and the T800 Model 101 that makes this movie so good, plus the plot surprises such as the fact that Skynet never existed because of actions in a different timeline,

vet a more sinister AI called "Legion" is trying to wipe out humanity this time. Juicing up the story even more is the inclusion of the enhanced human/cyborg ex-soldier Grace (played Canada's own amazing actor MacKenzie Davis) fighting the good fight.

There are some 'in jokes' throughout the movie, and more impressive for fans like me were the times when you think an obvious thing is going to happen-but it doesn't, leaving the viewer admiring the producers choice to present something new, and keep us on your toes as we watch the movie. My favourite movie franchises are "Star Wars", "Predator", "Planet of the Apes" and this one. This latest instalment in the Terminator franchise is well worth watching, even just to hear the line "I'll be back" once again.



#### **Cannabis and Taxes**

Cannabis can be a medical expense! Certain cannabis products bought for a patient for medical purposes are eligible for the medical expense tax credit.

The patient must:

- be a holder of a medical document as defined in the Cannabis Regulations
- be registered as a client of the holder of a licence for sale; and
- make their purchases from the holder of a licence for sale they are registered with.

Medical cannabis (marihuana) products include cannabis, cannabis oil, cannabis plant seeds, or cannabis products.

Medical cannabis is prescribed to treat a number of medical conditions including as a natural remedy for migraines, glaucoma, chronic pain and anxiety. However, only a handful of insurers in Canada offer optional coverage through workplace benefit plans — and it's usually only for more serious conditions such as cancer, HIV/AIDS, rheumatoid arthritis, multiple sclerosis, or patients in palliative care.

Bring all of your medical expenses with you when you come to prepare your taxes, even if you aren't sure you have enough to make a claim!
