## Take 2 with PAUL POWER

I'm a bit nostalgic revisiting Liam Gallagher's "As You Were" album, having also watched the rock documentary "Oasis-Supersonic"; Oasis imploded way back in August of 2009. They came to prominence in 1994 in Manchester, England-slugging it out onstage (sometimes literally) and with hard work, determination, stubbornness and sheer brilliance they eventually nabbed over 50 major UK and European music awards, and scored number-one singles and albums. By 2009 Oasis sold over 70 million records worldwide and were listed in the Guinness World Records book in

2010 for "Longest Top 10 UK Chart Run by a Group". They also hold the Guinness World Record for being the most successful act in the UK between 1995 and 2005, spending 765 weeks in the top 75 singles and albums charts. That's just over the pond-they captivated North America as well. But what brought Oasis together in the first place (brothers Liam and Noel Gallagher's love/hate relationship for each other) also tore the band apart. This is Liam's first solo album, and I nominated it as the best al-

bum of 2017. To hear the first song "Wall of Glass" blast out of the speakers was an absolute joy; the mighty heart and soul that drove Oasis was back and as tough as nails; that's the Liam Gallagher we came to know and love. Proof of Liam's 'I am better than Oasis', ballsy attitude and musical swagger is present on the songs "Bold", "Greedy Soul" (which has a John Mellencamp roots rock feel to it), "You Better Run" and "Come Back To Me"; all as good as anything Oasis ever did. "Paper Crown" sounds amazingly like a Beatles song, if sung by John Lennon-and that Fab Four sonic nod also shows up on "For What It's Worth" and the mellow "When I'm In Need". Yes, these songs are comparable to a number of songs by The Beatles-they're that good. On the song "I've All I Need"

Liam lets us hear a side of him that we've rarely heard-bold and fragile at the same time. The deluxe edition contains 3 extra songs; "Doesn't Have To Be That Way" is a full on-in your face distorted rock number, "All My People All Mankind" is again like Oasis, and "I Never Wanna Be Like You" is a great mid-tempo Beatles-like song. The best song overall here is definitely "Chinatown"-a very introspective number, and a great way to finish reviewing a fantastic album.

## LIBRARIES PARTIAL RE-OPENING

We would like to thank you for your continued patience and support of the library during this time. We know everyone is eager for the library to re-open.

There are many changes and precautions that need to be implemented prior to re-opening our library buildings. Library buildings will not be open initially but will begin offering limited services starting June 10th.

**LIBRARY CATALOGUE:** - You will be able to access your online account to see what items you still have checked out and to place new holds on items starting June 10th.

You can check your account by going to [cbrl.ca](http://cbrl.ca) and clicking on My Account. You will need your library card number and PIN to sign-in.

**RETURNS:** - Book-drops will be available at all branches starting June 10th. For branches which do not have permanent book-drops large bins will be placed outside the branch. To find out what hours the bin will be available please phone or e-mail your local branch. The book-drop at McConnell Library in Sydney is available 24/7 and can accept returns from any other branch.

As a precaution for COVID-19 all library items which are returned will be quarantined for a minimum of 5 days. This means that there will be a delay between when you return your items and when they are removed from your account.

All due dates for items currently out have been extended until June 30th. The library is not charging any late fees at this time.

**LIBRARY TAKE-OUT:** - Library members with items on hold will be contacted by library staff to arrange a time to pick-up the holds. This will be contactless curbside pick-up.
