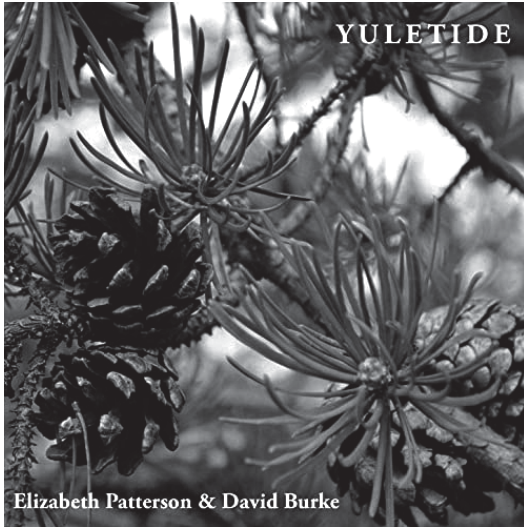

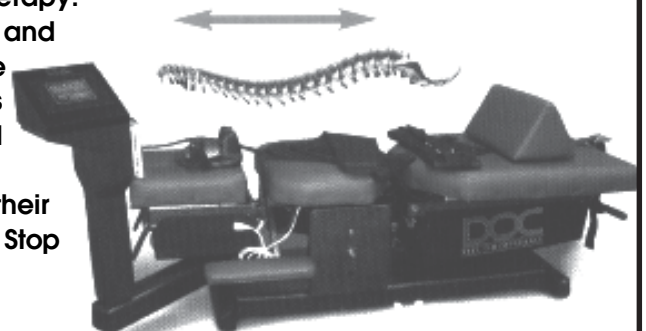

NEW FACES ON CBRM COUNCIL



The winds of change have blown through the CBRM and this was very evident in the recent CBRM civic election.

Cape Breton's first female Mayor was elected by a sizeable majority and there are 7 new Councillors joining the Council from within the CBRM.

Congratulations to Amanda McDougall, Mayor Elect and to Gordon MacDonald newly elected Councillor in District 1.



Incumbent Earlene MacMullin retained her seat in District 2 and will bring a wealth of experience to the position. Other new councillors are Cyril MacDonald (District 3), Steve Parsons (District 7), James Edwards (District 8), Ken Tracey (District 9), Darren O'Quinn (District 11), and Lorne Green (District 8).

Incumbents Ivan Doncaster in District 7 and Esmond (Blue) Marshall in District 3 failed to retain their seats while Earlene MacMullin, (District 2), Steve Gillespie (District 4), Eldon MacDonald (District 5), and Darren Bruckschwaiger (District 10) all were returned to Council.

Take 2 with PAUL POWER

I've written before about Brian Warner's life and music, and read books on him-so I thought who better to write about in the middle of this chaotic period than the 'antichrist superstar'. They say there's a fine line between genius and insanity, and as impressed and intrigued as I was before with the monster Brian Warner created (or became), this new album shines another light on **Marilyn Manson**-even if it that light has a blood red hue to it. The album was actually released in September, but the title track "**We Are Chaos**" came out in July and what a surprise it was to hear a song from Marilyn that's almost 'normal' sounding (the album was produced by Waylon Jennings son-Shooter Jennings) and the song was described thusly by Kerrang magazine; "it's [an] anthemic, celebratory, New Year's Eve feeling, dancing at the end of the world, that provides the energy on 'We Are Chaos'. The nihilism is pared back in favour of something more... romantic?" Wow-from Marilyn Manson? Yep. Similarly, "Paint You With My Love" has an almost country-blues hint to it (think Guns'N'Roses "November Rain") before morphing into a monster, and "Half-Way & One Step Forward" starts off with a great intro and reminds me of something Joy Division might have done. Returning to the fold, "Perfume" is the most trademark Marilyn Manson



song here, and it's a great number full of intensity with a maniacal groove; the album's opening track "Red, Black and Blue" is the Marilyn Manson we'd expect to hear-visceral, political, blasphemous and dark, with a spoken word intro by Marilyn that reminded me of Iggy Pop. Also, there's an amazing music video on YouTube for "Don't Chase The Dead", featuring "The Walking Dead's" Norman Reedus. There's no denying the fact that Marilyn Manson is shocking and incredibly controversial. However, recent world events have overshadowed his shock factor. Marilyn Manson is an entertainer; what we witness on the screens all around us is the true horror story. To prejudge this work would be a shame because this is Marilyn Manson's most accessible album ever; there are times when the songs are more like mainstream industrial rock-but don't be fooled by that, there are no kitten or cuddly puppy love songs on this album, it is not warm and fuzzy. It is a politically-charged, angry, aggressive and visceral collection that goes for the auditory throat. Would we expect anything different from him? Especially now?

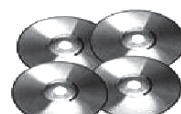

The children spent the preceding week researching, on line, making posters, and speaking about the various Northside, and Mayoral, candidates with the result only missing one of three; for the Clifford Street area the kiddoes picked Earlene, who did win, for Sydney Mines they picked Shara who lost, in hotly contested area, to Gordon, [kids say the darndest things!] and finally the children voted for Amanda as Mayor ~ and they were right again. On Monday we will discuss the outcome with the kiddies and carry on in preparation for some form of Halloween celebration with the kids. Mittens, the cat, remains tight lipped on how she voted but seemed pretty happy overall with the results ~ she was happy to see so many getting out and voting, high paw from her to those that voted!

While we are preparing for Halloween, and most importantly Remembrance Day [donate !!] with the children but we have our annual concerns to deal with... it is getting cold and wet.

We have been lucky with our weather in that it is warm this week, if damp, so our kids have faired off okay so far. [They grow out of their jackets so quickly and of course the co\$t is so high for childrens wear.] I did recieve a call from Tessa at Schwartz's in Sydney and they are soon starting their annual coat drive...and not to worry Clifford Street is included in the benefactor list! But we are now preparing for Christmas for the children, and seniors, as we have done for thirteen plus years...and trying how to accomodate covid. I have been in touch with the Northside Guest Home and we are sorting out how to pull off at least this annual tradition which is really appreciated by the children, seniors and especially the staff at the Northside Guest Home who fundraise and put on the annual event. This celebration had become one of our larger 'outside' events with us transporting children, and volunteers, to the guest home...not this year though. We have some thoughts around live streaming from our youth centre.... In the past we would hold three separate parties to include as many children as possible, up to 75 at one time, but this year requires new thinking.

As we move into the fall I expect more children to start to show up at Clifford Street, starting after Halloween as the past has shown, which will create more challenges on the food security front... and then providing gifts to all those children gets even harder. [thanks to those that donate by the way... Jeanie we would be lost without your support, planning & help!]

A special word; Several years ago we transported Northside children, and seniors, on a rented CBRM bus to tour around CBRM to look at all the Christmas lights. [it was a grant btw / we are unfunded !] At some spots the bus stopped, all of us got out and sang to the very proud homeowner, and we on to the next stop. Back then we arranged to meet with the then new Mayor, Cecil Clark, at his office. Here the children were enthusiastically greeted by Cecil and then given a tour of his corner office... even after free pizza... greasy finger prints

everywhere... Cecil was an incredible host. He told the children a Christmas story or two, and then asked if any of the children were from Clifford Street [not all our kids live nearby] with several children putting up their hands, Cecil then asked if anyone lived in # 14, with two girls putting up their hands... Cecil then went on to say that is where he grew up....[50 Clifford Street Housing project] Humble beginnings indeed... the kids were inspired and appreciative. Thanks to all to all those that ran in the recent municipal elections. Thank you Cecil for sharing with our kids...they remain inspired!

To those elected, we are 50 Clifford Street North Sydney, we are unfunded, volunteer based, survive on what grants we can get, and we need your help! We are not alone, there are many SMALL groups providing endless hours of community support, we are not nationally funded/recognized or supported... we do the work that no one else can, will, doesn't understand, doesn't know exists, or nationals talk about frequently as if they do know.... we are among the many hard working volunteer[s] groups in CBRM that need your support... Good luck to all those elected, thanks, from the children, for the teachable moment! Easy on the Halloween candy folks!
