Take 2 with PAUL POWER

Every now and then a movie comes out that absolutely blows you away-and after the end credit roll you just sit there thinking "oh my God!". This is one of those movies-but first a preamble: I know there are a lot of differing opinions out there about the safety of going to a local theatre to watch a movie. and with that in mind I decided to take a look at the first movie to make the big bold move to debut on the big screen since the pandemic shuttered movie theatres. Full disclosure though-I saw this film at home. "Unhinged" stars Russell Crowe in what for him is the unimaginable role of a totally psychotic murderer-he packed on the pounds and took on a southern American accent to play a person who is truly despicable, coldhearted and totally evil, as his character (Tom Cooper) hunts down a complete stranger and her son because the lady honked her horn when Cooper was idling at a green light. The events that ensue are visceral, horrific, shocking, outrageous and an outright condemnation of society's obsession with cellphones in cars, road rageand a total lack of civility, patience and our genuine level of humanity towards each other. As the story progresses we



learn more about Tom Cooper, and what put him on this path of total destruction. It's hard to find an action movie that finds the perfect balance between morality and 'go for the jugular' pacing-this movie nailed it 100 per-cent. I don't want to give away too much of the onscreen magic here but I will also say that I have never seen Russell Crowe play a character like this-and do it so well. His status in action movies is legendary, especially after playing Robin Hood and more importantly Maximus Decimus Meridius from "Gladiator", which is probably my favourite movie of all time. If you are a squeamish person this movie is not for you-but if you like good scares and want to see the results of the 'all-too-true' road rage that happens every day then grab some popcorn and plunk your butt down in front of the screen for what is one of the best action movies I've seen in 2020, and actually in years.
