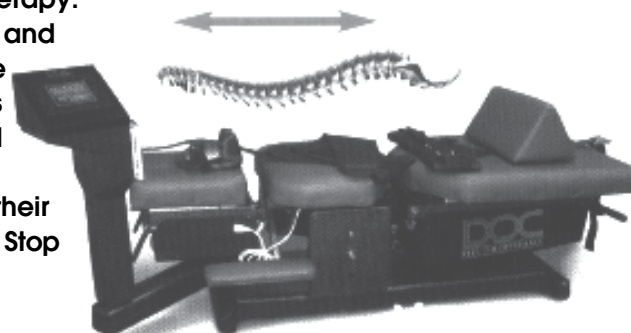

Heather and Tony Sampson, West Bay, Richmond County, have donated the annual Boston Christmas tree (DEPT. OF LANDS AND FORESTRY)

Nova Scotia has picked a 45-foot white spruce tree from Cape Breton Island to send to Boston as a thank you to the city for sending aid after the Halifax Explosion in 1917.

Heather and Tony Sampson from West Bay, Richmond Co. are this year's tree donors.

"It's been a tough year for everybody and hopefully the tree will put some smiles on everyone's faces. That's what the Tree for Boston is about, wishing everybody well and staying safe," said Heather Sampson.

"We thank Boston for their kindness during our time of need by sending a big, beautiful Nova Scotia Christmas tree," said Lands and Forestry Minister Derek Mombourquette. "This important tradition symbolizes gratitude, friendship and remembrance."

Tony Sampson says there is also a family connection to Boston. "My stepfather's mother was adopted from Boston when she was two. The tree comes from our property, which was passed down through the family. We've watched it grow for many years. It has quite a bit of meaning to me and my family to send Nova Scotia's gift to the people of Boston," said Tony Sampson.

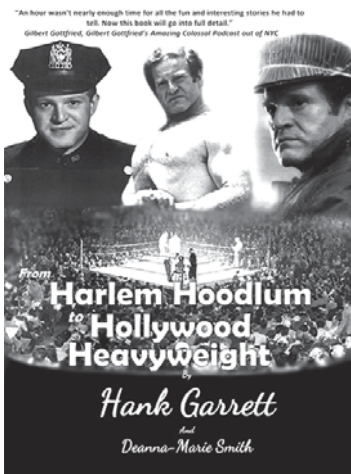

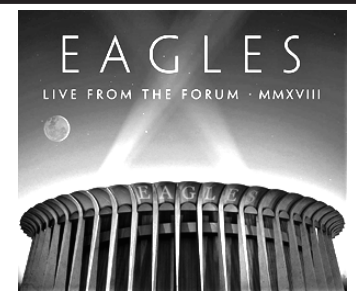

I'm generally not a big fan of live albums but when I saw this recent release on the shelves at Atomic Records & Collectibles it grabbed my attention for a few reasons; 1)-band member Timothy B. Schmit recently celebrated his 73rd birthday, 2)-the band's "Hell Freezes Over" live collection came out 26 years ago this month, 3)-the album is by the Eagles, and 4)-the album is by the Eagles! To elaborate, when Glen Frey passed away in 2016 fellow bandmember Don Henley said that it was the end of the Eagles. Interestingly enough, Glen's son Deacon stepped up to the plate, and with country star Vince Gill tagging along they re-formed, and returned to the stage. Henley later said "the only way it felt justified to me was to have family blood in the band" so Deacon was welcomed with open arms. This collection, "**Live from the Forum MMXVIII**", chronicles the band's 3 night stand at the Forum in Inglewood, California, and the first to feature Deacon Frey & Vince Gill. There are over 30 tracks in the collection but I went directly to the key songs that resonated most with me; Timothy's amazing voice was such a welcomed sound to hear again on "I Can't Tell You Why" and the band's harmonies on "Seven Bridges Road" is pure



audio joy. There are way too many great songs to cover in detail, but to choose a few more-the beginning of "One Of These Nights" is a much-welcomed refrain, and the trumpet intro to the wonderfully exotic and legendary "Hotel California" is a fan's delight as Don Henley carries the lyrics so well in this version. Glen Frey said that he and Henley wanted the song "to open like an episode of the Twilight Zone", and added: "We take this guy and make him like a character in "The Magus" where every time he walks through a door there's a new version of reality. We wanted to write a song just like it was a movie." To close, this album is available in multiple audio and video formats (The concert was recorded on 14 4k cameras, so the quality is amazing) and in various configurations, including the die-hard fan's choice-a super deluxe box set with Blu-ray, two CDs and four LP's. The collection definitely has a greatest hits vibe to it-with the live performances of the songs acting as the icing on the cake.
