I had the pleasure last week of interviewing one the cast members of the upcoming




fan film Jason Rising directed by James Sweet. I had the pleasure of doing a Skype interview with Anna Campbell as Deputy Eve Glover.


ames Taylor celebrated birthday number 72 this month, and it's hard to believe it was 52 years ago that James Taylor released his self-titled debut album, with the song "Carolina On My Mind" as the first single (the song would be re-recorded in 1976 for the version that most

people are familiar with) but it was 1970's "Fire And Rain" that really brought James to the attention of the musical mainstream. I absolutely love his greatest hits collection from 1976, with every

song on it being a sonic masterpiece. Coincidentally, I have a cousin and I had an uncle (who passed away a number of years ago) with the same name; I always thought that was cool when I was a kid/teenager. James Taylor went on to sell over 100 million albums, and score a number of top 10 hits over the decades. That success was not without great pain though; James was addicted to heroin, had mental health issues, and plenty of heartache over the decades (he was married, then divorced from Carly Simon after 11 years), as well as losing his son Alex in 1993, on James actual birthday. It's a wonder that Mr. Taylor is still with us. This release, "American Standard". marks solo album number 20 for Mr. Taylor, and although there are no original songs here-it's because this time out James looked at the Great American Songbook for inspiration. The first single that was released was the jazzy and soulful "Teach Me Tonight", a song usually associated with Frank Sinatra

and Dinah Washington, and it gets a n i c e treatment here. The most familiar tracks are "My Blue Heaven", "Ol' Man River", "Moon River" and "God Bless The

Child"-all of which are delivered in James effortless vocal sashay and sway, with "Almost Like Being In Love" sounding the most like a James Taylor original of all the numbers here. Admittedly, like much of James Taylor's back catalogue, this album is easy-listening fare, best thought of as a soundtrack for a rainy day, a lazy Sunday afternoon-or in a coffee house setting. But the fact that we still have new songs from James Vernon Taylor to listen to is cause for celebration-he is indeed an American standard.



CORONA VIRUS NEWS

Nova Scotia Premier Stephen McNeil has declared a province-wide state of emergency.

- No more than five people permitted to gather in one location
- Provincial parks are closed, visitors will be considered to be trespassing, cars will be towed
- Effective Monday at 6 a.m., all Nova Scotians returning from province must self-isolate for a period of 14 days
- Screening to be managed at New Brunswick border, at ferry terminals in Digby and North Sydney and at airports in Halifax and Sydney
- Exceptions are being made for those providing essential services, including truckers, health care and child protection workers, and law enforcement
- No entry into Nova Scotia for social reasons
- Police authorized to enforce orders under Health Protection Act related to self-isolation and social distancing
- Fines for violating orders under the Act for individuals start at \$1,000 per violation, per day; businesses and corporations face fines starting at \$7,500 per violation, per day

TAX TIPS COLUMN

Tax Tips for Canadians over 65

Make sure you file a tax return: - Always file, because you could be entitled to other credits, deductions and benefits that get triggered by your tax return such as GST/HST credits. If you're receiving Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS) through Old Age Security, make sure to file on time to ensure their benefits continue uninterrupted.

Income split and save - You're allowed to split up to half of your eligible pension income with a spouse or common-law partner. Income splitting allows some seniors to enjoy a significant tax reduction. In the situation where the lower-income spouse has very little income, the tax savings are substantial. If your spouse is unable to completely offset his or her age amount, pension income and disability amount against tax payable, he or she may transfer the unused portion to your return.

Split your CPP and save - You may be able to split part of your CPP retirement benefits with your spouse depending on how long you lived together when you were contributing to the plan. This is an advantage if one senior is in a higher tax bracket than the other. However, to do so, you must apply to Human Resources & Social Development Canada using Form ISP-1002. It cannot be done at the time of tax preparation.

Double check how foreign pension income is taxed - Pensions from foreign countries may be subject to special tax treatment under the terms of a tax treaty. Always check with a tax professional to find out if the pension you receive from a foreign source is taxable in Canada.

Medical expenses can add up - A portion of most medical expenses can be claimed! Everything from medication to nursing home fees, and even medical insurance for a trip or wintering in another country is considered eligible. Medical expenses are reduced by a percentage of your income, so it is normally more beneficial for the lower income spouse to claim them.

And if you had to travel to obtain medical treatment that was not available where you live, you may be able to claim the cost of transportation, meals and accommodation.
