

AROUND THE TOWN

I have noticed that there are many more apparent violations of the **social distancing** in the last week - people walking alongside one another and others chatting with neighbours and crowding in some fast food outlets some of the excuses I have heard are - "it only affects older people" or "I don't have any symptoms"..... we have learned from medical experts that you may be carrying the virus and not experience **any symptoms** or very mild ones - I ask you to take the social distancing **seriously** until the outbreak is contained - instances of house parties are just not in the best **interests** of any Cape Bretoners... I have included some recent guidelines printed in the **Cape Breton Post** by Sharon Montgomery - As of Monday, regional police have issued 66 violations under the provincial state of emergency and have now received more than 500 calls related to COVID-19 complaints.

Magnus said police are often asked about driving regulations and the number of persons permitted in a vehicle.

The Health Protection Act states that all Nova Scotians must maintain a distance of six feet apart from one another.

"If you can't be six feet apart in the same vehicle, then you can't be in the same vehicle with that person," she said.

However, the exceptions would be people who live in the same household because they already share the same physical space, so social distancing wouldn't be a factor. Vehicle exceptions also include essential workers travelling to work — such as health-care workers — who are exempt from social-distancing rules.

"If those individuals are travelling to the same place of work and there's no other means for them to get there, it would likely be OK for them to carpool together."

Magnus said police will continue to enforce the law and suggests the public educate themselves by going to www.novascotia.ca/coronavirus for more information.

Take 2 with PAUL POWER

3 years ago last month the world lost the TRUE king of rock and roll; Chuck Berry was credited by the likes of The Rolling Stones, Bruce Springsteen, The Beatles and countless other rock and roll pioneers as such. According to Rolling Stone magazine Chuck Berry was a very hard person to get along with, did have

a shady past, and burned many bridges over the years-but no one could deny the fact that he invented rock and roll. This album **"Chuck"** was a bittersweet release-it had

been 38 years since Chuck Berry released an album, and this was his last. Recording was completed on schedule before Chuck's death, for which his estate was prepared; three days after his death (on March 18th) it was announced that the album would be released on June 16, 2017. Also on that day Chuck Berry's first single in 40 years hit the airwaves; "Big Boys" was a signature Chuck Berry song that's a blast from the past to the heyday of oldies rock and roll, and is a wicked tune all about a teenager wanting to



do all the things that the big boys do. Even more significant is the sequel song "Lady B. Goode" which is almost a carbon copy of the original song, but has enough of a new vibe to make it an instant classic. As for the other songs here, "Wonderful Woman" is an updated homage to his wife of 68 years (the first song was, of course "Little Queenie"). There is a live version of the borderline silly, but so enjoyable "3/4 time" and "You Go To My Head" sounds steamy and sultry. On a

different note "Darlin'" is a slow jam that sounds like an old country honky-tonk standard, which Berry wrote for his daughter, and "Jamaica Moon" is a rum-heavy ditty,

complete with 'ya mon' Rasta style vocals. One of the most heartfelt songs on the album is "She Still Loves You", which comes across as very personal and intimate, with Chuck Berry's signature guitar solos. The album closes off with the number "Eyes Of A Man" and it's a fitting close on the final chapter of the music of Charles Edward Anderson Berry-born on October 18th, 1926-died on March 18th, 2017. Chuck can duke it out with Elvis Presley in the great beyond for who is the true King of Rock and Roll-my money is on Berry to win by a TKO.




TAX TIPS COLUMN

BENEFITS AND CREDITS - Canada training credit limit – Eligible workers of at least 25 years old and less than 65 years old at the end of 2019 and later years, and who meet certain conditions will accumulate \$250 a year, up to a lifetime limit of \$5,000 to be used in calculating their Canada Training Credit, a new refundable tax credit available for 2020 and future years.

Based on the information on their return, the CRA will determine their Canada training credit limit for the 2020 tax year and provide it to them on their notice of assessment for 2019 and will be available in My Account.

For 2020 and future years, an individual may be able to claim a Canada Training Credit equal to their Canada Training Credit Limit for the year or 50% of their eligible tuition and fees paid to an educational Institution in Canada, whichever is less.

CANADA WORKERS BENEFIT – The Canada workers benefit, formerly the working income tax benefit, is a refundable tax credit available to eligible individuals and families who work, but earn low income. As of February 2020, a simplified version of the advance payments application will be available in My Account.

CANADA PENSION PLAN (CPP) ENHANCEMENT – On January 1, 2019, Canadians began contributing more to the Canada Pension Plan. You can claim a deduction for your enhanced contributions to the CPP. Annual contribution rates will rise modestly over seven years. This change helps increase retirement income for working Canadians and their families.

CHANGES FOR INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES - Withdrawals have increased under the Home Buyers' Plan – The maximum amount you can withdraw from your registered retirement savings plan under the Home Buyers' Plan increased from \$25,000 to \$35,000 for withdrawals made after March 19, 2019.

CANNABIS AS A MEDICAL EXPENSE – Certain cannabis products bought for a patient for medical purposes are eligible for the medical expense tax credit. The patient must: be a holder of a medical document as defined in the Cannabis Regulations be registered as a client of the holder of a licence for sale; and make their purchases from the holder of a licence for sale they are registered with.
