Admittedly, Daniel O'Donnell's music may not be the cat's meow for everybody, with some considering it 'Celtic Lite' or 'touristy Irish', but you have to give the man credit-he knows what he's good at, who his audience is-and what they want to hear. Daniel has sold well over 10 million albums thus far-and has released more than 3 dozen

of them. His big career move was back in 1983; after years of being in his sister M a r g o 's showband and t o u r i n g O 'D o n n e II released his debut solo

album, with Johnny McCauley's "My Donegal Shore" released as the single. It wasn't long before Daniel was performing across the United Kingdom, and eventually North America. Daniel's music has often been described as a mix between Country and Irish Folk music, and it's his genuine appreciation of-and dedication to his fanbase that has made him a household name in many countries. He is also considered an ambassador for his home

county of Donnegal, Ireland. Although his musical base is predominately Celtic Daniel O'Donnell also visits other musical styles-and this collection walks that different "Halfway path. То Paradise" is a 3-CD collection of 60 classic rock and roll songs, and with so many good songs it's hard to look at them all-so I'll single out some of the real standouts: "Daydream Believer", "Donna", "Sealed With A Kiss", "Beautiful Sunday", "Is This The Way To Amarillo" and "You Are My Special Angel" are pretty



m u c h p e r f e c t numbers. If you're a fan of the music from the 1950's, 60's and 70's t h e s e recordings will be right up your

alley. Some other highlights are "It Doesn't Matter Any More", "Wooden Heart", "Rhythm Of The Rain" and "But I Do"-to again name just a few of the great selections here. Daniel also livens the collection up even more by presenting live song medleys by The Beatles, Cliff Richard and Elvis Presley. All in all, Daniel O'Donnell's die hard fans are going to love this collection-for everyone else, just hearing these songs helps us understand why they will.





GENERAL - Make sure you file your income tax return on time if you have a balance due, even f you cannot pay right away. By doing so you will avoid the late filing penalty which can be costly.

GENERAL - If you turn 19 before April 1st, 2020, make sure you file a 2018 income tax return in order to receive the GST/HST credit. You will get at least 1 GST cheque for the payment following your birthday.

GENERAL - Old charitable donation receipts that you forgot to clam in previous years shoud not be thrown away. Charitable receipts are good for 5 years after the year in which the donation was made.

FAMILIES - If you deposit your Canada Child Benefit into a separate bank account specifically for your child, any interest it earns is considered your child's income rather than yours. Your child can earn \$12,069 in the 2019 taxation year before being subject to federal tax.

SENIORS - If you have to make renovations to your home in order to make it safer or more accessible, you can claim a 15% credit for the first \$10,000 of your expenses.

SENIORS - If you have to travel more than 40 kilometers in order to get your medical treatment which is not available locally, you can claim the cost of transportation as a medical expense. If you have to travel more than 80 kilometers, you can also claim other travel expenses such as meals and accommodation.

FAMILIES - Inform the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) if there are any changes in your family circumstances which could affect your GST credit
