

Atlantic Bubble Explained



Makin' Waves 2020 Canceled, Songwriters Studio and Drive-In Concert to Take Place

When the last notes of Port Cities closed the 2019 edition of Sydney Credit Union Makin' Waves, the countdown began for when our community could again gather for live music in Wentworth Park. With a global pandemic looming, travel and gathering restrictions in place, and the health and wellbeing of our community in consideration, we today announce the formal cancellation of the 2020 edition of Sydney Credit Union Makin' Waves.

All is not lost, however, as the last few months have allowed the Makin' Waves team to reinvent and redevelop plans on how to offer musical experiences to our community.

First will be the Cape Breton University Songwriters Studio: Isolation Edition. Four intimate episodes will delve deeply into the songs and careers of four Makin' Waves alumni: Carleton Stone of Port Cities, Jah'Mila of Jamaica/Halifax, Rosanna Burrill of Halifax's Hillsburn, and Cape Breton born songwriter Greg MacPherson. The weekly series will launch June 25th on www.makinwavesfestival.ca and will be followed by a two part live/digital edition later in the year.

Secondly, the CBMIC Front Stage Program returns to focus on the development of young songwriters in Cape Breton. For 2020, artists selected for the Front Stage Program will work to develop a live performance video as well as an introduction video to use in promotion of their work.

Finally, CBRM Recreation will host a two night live and livestreamed concert on August 22nd and 23rd from the Cape Breton Drive-In. A limited audience will be given the opportunity to watch live from their vehicles as artists bring excitement to the stage, while a global audience will be able to watch from home as the concert is presented online. This event will be free, with ticketing information and lineup to be announced in July.

lan Thomas's "A Life in Song" was released almost 4 years ago and it was a pleasant surprise; to refresh some memories, lan Thomas is a Canadian singer/songwriter who came to prominence in 1973 with his hit song "Painted Ladies". Over the years he released 15 albums, had top 10 hits and his songs have been performed by Santana,

Chicago, Bette Midler, America and others. Ian also formed the band The **Boomers** in 1991-releasing 4 albums. He's also comedian Dave Thomas' s brother. lan already had 2

greatest hits albums out, but that's where this new one was a departure-rather than just releasing the 'same old same old' lan decided to record orchestral reinterpretations of his songs with the acclaimed Prague Philharmonic Orchestra. Ian said: "our goal was to integrate the song right into the orchestra or in some cases to use the orchestra to underscore the lyric," and what we got here was a fresh new take on some of lan's old favourites, some recent stuff and a new song. As mentioned earlier, Ian's song "Painted Ladies" was his career kickstart, and revisiting the

song was a treat; unexpectedly a harp ushers in the number, as the familiar organ sound on the original version is subdued, but still present. It's a great take on an old classic. Personally I like lan's song "Right Before Your Eyes" most of all, and to hear this version is magic to the ears. The number is a hauntingly beautiful and emotional ode to a 'love from afar' and how the singer is finally going to take his chance, introduce himself and hope that she feels the same about him. The other song I would pick as the best here is lan's classic

"Long Long Way". The original version had an almost funky vibe to it, and that spirit is maintained, but layered with horchestrations

that make the song so much more vibrant and timeless. The new track is "So Cold In The City", and it reminds me of a song Sting or Mark Knopfler would do-and that's a definite compliment to Ian. The song has a lonely and haunting quality to it, but has a tiny glimmer of hope that makes it truly enjoyable and memorable. Without mentioning every song here I do want to give nods to "Pilot" and "The Runner", two of lan's more well known songs that absolutely sparkle and shine with the new treatments given to them. Simply put-this is a great album.



LIBRARIES PARTIAL RE-OPENING

We would like to thank you for your continued patience and support of the library during this time. We know everyone is eager for the library to re-open.

There are many changes and precautions that need to be implemented prior to re-opening our library buildings. Library buildings will not be open initially but will begin offering limited services starting June 10th.

LIBRARY CATALOGUE: - You will be able to access your online account to see what items you still have checked out and to place new holds on items starting June 10th.

You can check your account by going to cbrl.ca and clicking on My Account. You will need your library card number and PIN to sign-in.

RETURNS: - Book-drops will be available at all branches starting June 10th. For branches which do not have permanent bookdrops large bins will be placed outside the branch. To find out what hours the bin will be available please phone or e-mail your local branch. The book-drop at McConnell Library in Sydney is available 24/7 and can accept returns from any other branch.

As a precaution for COVID-19 all library items which are returned will be quarantined for a minimum of 5 days. This means that there will be a delay between when you return your items and when they are removed from your account.

TAX TIPS COLUMN

New tax filing and payment deadlines

The deadline for most individuals to file their 2019 taxes has been extended to June 1, 2020. The deadline to pay amounts owed has also been extended to September 1, 2020. Penalties and interest will not be charged if payments are made by the extended deadlines of September 1, 2020. This includes the latefiling penalty as long as the return is filed by September 1, 2020.

If you, your spouse, or your common-law partner are self-employed, you still have until June 15, 2020, to file your taxes. However, your payment deadline has also been extended to September 1, 2020.

For those who have to pay by instalments, the June 15, 2020, payment due date has also been extended to September 1st. Instalment penalties and interest will not be charged for this payment if it is made by the extended deadline of September 1, 2020.

For more information on the filing and payment deadline changes due to COVID-19, go to Income tax filing and payment deadlines: CRA and COVID-19.

Why file by the deadline if no payment is due until September 1?

Filing by the deadline will minimize impacts to your benefit and credit payments. If your 2019 return has not been assessed by the CRA, information from your 2018 return will be used to calculate benefit and credit payments until September 2020. That will ensure you continue to receive important payments that will help through the COVID-19 crisis. However, you may not be getting exactly the right amounts. By filing a return by the deadline, you will minimize this impact. Also, if you are owed a refund, the earlier you file, the earlier it will arrive in your pocket. By registering for direct deposit, you'll get your refund even faster.
