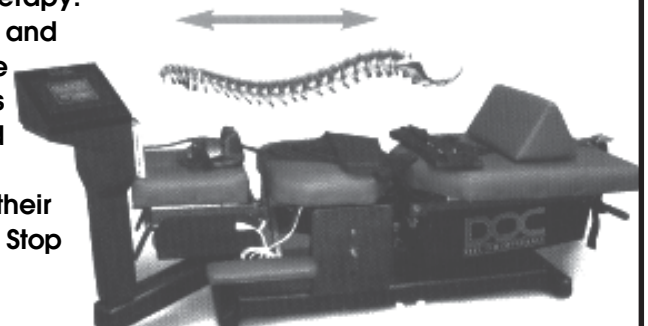

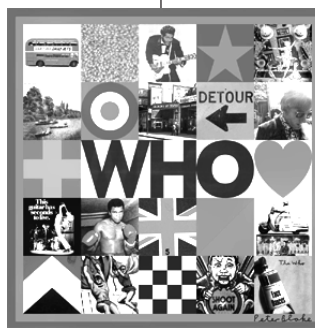
Take 2 with PAUL POWER

It's been 13 years since the Who released an album, and only 4 were put out since Keith Moon died in 1978, so a release from the band is reason enough to take notice-plus the fact that the band has been around in one form or another for over 50

years, and that they ARE a Legendary rock and roll band with a capital 'L' totally justifies giving this collection of new songs a good listen to. Obviously the

album only has 50% of the original band in tow; Rodger Daltry and Pete Townsend. Drummer Kenny Jones and bassist John Entwistle had longstanding disagreements with other band members over the years and parted ways a long time ago. Let's be honest though, Daltry and Townsend ARE the Who. So how does the "WHO" album stack up? Well, there's no earth-shattering departures here-just what you'd normally expect from the Who as they approach their mid 70's; the first track says it all, as the lyrics in "All This Music Will Fade" spells it out for us clearly as Rodger sings "I

don't care, I know you're gonna hate this song" and later on in the same number "I don't mind, other guys ripping off my songs" with a big F bomb at the end...so get ready for some songs that lay it on the line, with lyrics that don't candy-coat what the boys think and feel. As for some of the other songs, "Detour" sounds similar to Pete's solo stuff from years ago, "Street Song" is a good anthem-like number and



"Break The News" carries a more mellow feel that does get heavier on the chorus just nicely; the song "Ball and Chain" is basically a bluesy protest

song against Guantanamo Bay (don't like the message but like the song) and "I Don't Wanna Get Wise" has hints of the teenage wasteland from the band's yesteryears; one of the bonus song included is "Danny And The Ponies", featuring Pete Townsend on vocals, and it's probably the best song of all. The album does slip off the main path just a bit on a few songs-but they are far outweighed by the better ones. So is this album good? Let's put it this way-every year we lose more and more of the pioneers of rock and roll, so let's cherish them while they're still here.

TAX TIPS COLUMN

CANADA TRAINING CREDIT LIMIT

Eligible workers of at least 25 years old and less than 65 years old at the end of 2019 and later years, and who meet certain conditions will accumulate \$250 a year, up to a lifetime limit of \$5,000 to be used in calculating their Canada Training Credit, a new refundable tax credit available for 2020 and future years.

Based on the information on their return, the CRA will determine their Canada training credit limit for the 2020 tax year and provide it to them on their notice of assessment for 2019 and will be available in My Account.

You may be able to claim both the Canada training credit and the tuition tax credit in the same year. However, in calculating your tuition tax credit, your eligible tuition and fees paid for the year will be reduced by the Canada training credit you claim in that year.

The Canada training credit claimed on your income tax and benefit return will reduce your tax owing. If the credit is more than your tax owing, you will get a refund for the difference.

For 2020 and future years, an individual may be able to claim a Canada Training Credit equal to their Canada Training Credit Limit for the year or 50% of their eligible tuition and fees paid to an educational institution in Canada, whichever is less.

If you're in need of clarification on your personal situation, bring in your tuition receipts when you come to file your taxes.
