Welcome to a year where our vision is perfect! Last month I had the chance to great books 2 read courtesy of the Cape Breton Regional Library (please support them in any-and every way you can). Both books had so much information in them that it's difficult summarize, but in a nutshell here goes; the first was "Randy Bachman's Vinyl Tap Stories"; a collection of his best tales and recollections from his CBC Radio program of the same name, and of course about his time with Brave Belt. BTO. Ironhorse and The Guess Who, and how it all started with an inspired 15 year old Randy seeing Elvis Presley for the first time on television. Of course Randy Bachman has been an integral part of the Canadian Rock music scene since the early 1960's, and is recognized internationally for his great guitar skills, songwriting talents, being a pioneer of hard rock in this country, and for just being an allround nice guy. The book is filled with amusing anecdotes, music trivia, road stories and some music business tales from Canada, the United States

Randy's own words. Guitar players will especially like Randv's encyclopedic knowledge of guitars and recording studio tales about some of Canada's best rock songs ever. Again, there's too many cool things to read about in this book to cover hereso check it out for yourself (um...library pun there...never mind). The second "Nowhere with You: The East Coast Anthems of Joel Plaskett, **Emergency and Thrush** Hermit" by Josh O'Kane. The book basically serves as a history lesson for this province's alternative rock scene in the 1990's, the "Seattle North" music industry boom that never happened-and how so many artists had to move away over the years to "make it"; Joel's steadfast determination to keep his home base anchored in Nova Scotia-even as he traveled throughout Canada, the United States and Europe performing, recording nspirational. Those of us who have tasted life away from N.S. realize that once the Atlantic Ocean's salt water is in your blood it's there to stay. All in all, this is a great book is about a city, a musical scene (past and present) and one heck of a talented musician who's one of our own.
