



LYNYRD SKYNYRD-"Live

from Jacksonville" is a concert DVD that documents a long-time dream for the band; to go back to their home town in of Jacksonville, Florida to perform their first two albums live over a 2-night period ("Pronounced Leh-Nerd Skin-Nerd" on the first night and "Second Helping" on the second night). The only 'original' member on this stage was lead guitarist Gary Rossington but that doesn't take anything away from the performance. Without covering every song I'm starting with the first night and the "Pronounced Leh-Nerd Skin-Nerd" album by going right to the fourth song; "Simple Man" has sentimental meaning for me because of a family wedding. The song tells the tale of a mother talking to her only son, telling him what kind of man she wants him to grow up to be-and the song's uplifting lyrics are heartfelt. The performance here is absolutely spellbinding and intense, which you can see on the band's faces even after all these years. Of course, "Tuesday's Gone" has to be mentioned, with the amazing version here-and after years the legendary "Freebird" still rings true as one of the greatest classic rock and roll anthems of all time. Night 2 shines as bright as the sun with the opening song "Sweet Home Alabama". Not many bands can say they have a classic rock and



roll anthem; Lynyrd Skynyrd can claim 2. This legendary number started out as a slam on Neil Young's songs "Southern Man" and "Alabama" and quickly became a rock and roll standard. "Don't Ask Me No Questions" and "Call Me The Breeze" really shows how good the band is live, and "The Ballad Of Curtis Loew" and "The Needle And The Spoon" highlight the band's storytelling skills through lyrics. The late Ronnie Van Zant was the original singer on the albums, but his younger brother Johnny has been the lead vocalist for the band since 1987, and does a phenomenal job handling the songs. This DVD looks brilliant and sounds great. The video is 1080p resolution, with audio available in DTS Digital Surround, Dolby Digital: 5.1 Surround and 2.0 Stereo. Plus there's a bonus feature-a backstage visit with the band. Lynyrd Skynyrd are without a doubt the kings of Southern Rock and Roll-and this DVD lets us see and hear why.

GRASS FIRE SAFETY

A grass fire differs from other fires by its extensive size, the speed at which it can spread out form its original source, its potential to change direction unexpect-



edly and its ability to jump gaps such as roads, rivers and fire breaks. To prevent dangerous grass fires, assess your property to determine its risk. Tall trees, wild grass, shrubs and any other combustible materials can all contribute to spreading a fire. During drought or extended lengths of dry weather, this vegetation can become perfect fuel for a fire driven by strong winds. Some simple planning will greatly reduce the threat to your home, property and community.

- * Do not throw cigarette or cigar butts on the ground or out of a vehicle. Dispose of them properly and make sure the are completely extinguished.
- * Keep a 30 foot "safety zone" surrounding your home. This area should be clear of brush, with grass cut short. Store firewood and other combustible materials at least 30 feet away from any buildings. For homes that sit on a steep slope, the safety zone should be increased accordingly.
- * Keep your yard healthy, cut and watered it is a natural firebreak.
- *Clean up dead leaves and twigs from yard, roof and gutters. Cut tree limbs within 15 feet of the ground and remove dead branches that extend over the roof.
- * Do not park cars, trucks or recreational vehicles on dry grass or shrubs. Exhaust systems on vehicles can reach temperatures of more than 500° C. It only takes about 200° C to start a grass fire in the Summer.
- * Use an approved spark arrester on all internal combustion engine power equipment. This special muffler helps ensure that sparks generated by off road vehicles, chainsaws and other equipment don't start grass fires.
- * Parents should emphasize to their children the dangers of playing with fire. Children who have no idea how quickly flames can grow and spread, start many grass fires.
- * Homeowners who barbecque should maintain a 10 foot area free of brush and shrubbery around grills and propane tanks. Never leave a grill unattended.
- * Keep a shovel, buckets of water, fire extinguisher or garden hose on hand any time while burning outside.
- * If conducting a controlled burn, have a water hose close by and inform your local fire department before burning.





TAX TIPS COLUMN

Changes for individuals and families

Withdrawals have increased under the Home Buyers' Plan – The maximum amount you can withdraw from your registered retirement savings plan under the Home Buyers' Plan increased from \$25,000 to \$35,000 for withdrawals made after March 19, 2019.

CANNABIS AS A MEDICAL EXPENSE – Certain cannabis products bought for a patient for medical purposes are eligible for the medical expense tax credit.

The patient must:

be a holder of a medical document as defined in the Cannabis Regulations

be registered as a client of the holder of a licence for sale; and make their purchases from the holder of a licence for sale they are registered with.

TUITION AND ENROLMENT CERTIFICATE – The new T2202, Tuition and Enrolment Certificate replaces T2202A, Tuition and Enrolment Certificate for the 2019 and following tax years. Flying schools and clubs will now report information on the new T2202

KINSHIP CARE PROVIDERS – For 2009 and later years, for the Canada workers benefit and the former working income tax benefit, a care provider may be considered to be the parent of a child in their care, regardless of whether they receive financial assistance from a government under a kinship care program. As a result, the care provider may be entitled to claim the child as an eligible dependent for purposes of claiming the benefit.

Also, for these years, financial assistance payments received by care providers under a kinship care program are not included in income and not included when determining entitlement to benefits and credits based on income.

COMMUNAL ORGANIZATIONS – For 2014 and later tax years, business income earned by the trust that is allocated to a member of the communal organization is deemed to be income from a business carried on by that member. This may allow members of a communal organization to claim the Canada workers benefit for 2019 and later years and the working income tax benefit for the 2014 to 2018 tax years.
