

Tomorrow is a day of celebration-and a historical one. Another thing that is historical is the fact that Tom Jones recently became the oldest male to get a number 1 album on the UK music charts. At 80 vears of age Tom released "Surrounded By Time"-his fortyfirst studio album. It also happens to be Tom's fourth album of all cover songs. So how are the songs? Well, what did surprise me was the choice of material for the album: for me the most familiar song here is The Waterboys "This Is The Sea", and Tom's take on it is pretty good. As for the others, "Talking Reality TV Blues" (by American singer/songwriter Todd Snider) was released as a single-and this trip hop number takes a punch at the mindlessness of reality TVwhich by definition really doesn't exist once a camera and production crew are introduced into the environment. Tom's take on the Bob Dylan song "One More Cup Of Coffee" is wonderful, and "No Hole In My Head" is given a swinging 60's flavour that really lifts the track up. The song "Lazarus Man" really caught me by surprise as well with its spoken word verses and biblical bent-interesting. very interesting. That similar vibe runs through Tom's cover of Tony Joe White's song "OI" Mother Earth". The funkiest track here is definitely "Pop Star" as Tom



gives the Cat Stevens penned song a new twist, and Tom's cover of the classic song "Windmills Of Your Mind" is probably the best song in this collection. Tom first sang the song "Delilah" way back in 1968-and now sings the traditional number "Samson and Delilah", with a jive and bop tempo that really highlights Tom's 'Northern Soul' side. To be honest. Tom's 3 previous cover albums were a bit betterbut when you factor in Tom's age, and that this album almost didn't happen one needs to celebrate his return: with the passing of his wife Linda Rose in 2016 Tom canceled all his tour dates-and earlier this year said "I didn't know if I could sing. When you get too emotional, your voice doesn't work ... It knocked me completely off balance". Taking his wife's advice Tom sold his L.A. Mansion and moved to a flat in London, England. She also wanted him to continue performing and recording-and that's why we have this latest effort.


