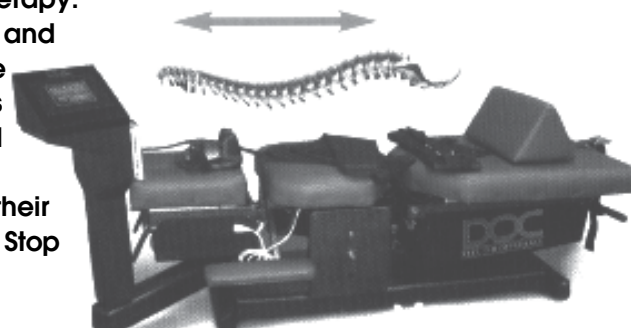

JOHN CABOT'S GHOST SHIP

On June 24th, 1497, John Cabot discovered Cape Breton Island. He sailed in a small ship called "The Matthew" and he was looking for the North West Passage which would lead them to the riches of the Orient.

As with many of the voyages during this period, they were recorded in detail as many of the expeditions were financed and the backers wanted information about what was found or any riches discovered. History details that one of the voyages, the 1497 voyage to Cape Breton, was sponsored by rich merchants who were looking for oak timber which was used extensively to build ships.

Cabot explored the Island checking all the inlets and coves for the elusive oak trees. Nothing unusual occurred during this exploration but stories abound even to this day of a small wooden ship appearing suddenly on the horizon and it is unusual as not many wooden ships ply the Atlantic Ocean waters surrounding Cape Breton these days.

The local newspapers have published stories about the ghost ship and a few years ago, Cape Breton celebrated the 500th anniversary of Cabot's discovery of Cape Breton. Several accounts described the wooden ship and some accounts included drawings of the ship.

It was only when pictures of the original Matthew appeared in the local newspaper that the connection was made between the ghost ship and the Matthew, Cabot's ship. If you are ever sailing around Cape Breton Island and a wooden ship appears suddenly, see if you can capture a picture of it or write down the description so you can compare it with the Matthew. No valid reason has ever been given as to why the ship keeps appearing here.

It's Movie time! As soon as I saw a trailer for this movie I was filled with anticipation to see it-and now I did; **"The Hitman's Wife's Bodyguard"** is the sequel to 2017's "The Hitman's Bodyguard" and sees the return of Ryan Reynolds, Samuel L. Jackson, Salma Hayek and Richard E. Grant in what can only be described as an over-the-top action/comedy. The story in a nutshell is that Reynolds is a disgraced high profile bodyguard who is advised to get away, chill out and refrain from all violence, guns and general craziness-all of which were integral parts of his job. The movie has a surprise ending-actually 2, so make sure to stay with it until the end credits. Also, like "Deadpool" this movie has a killer (no pun intended) soundtrack. Enjoy!
