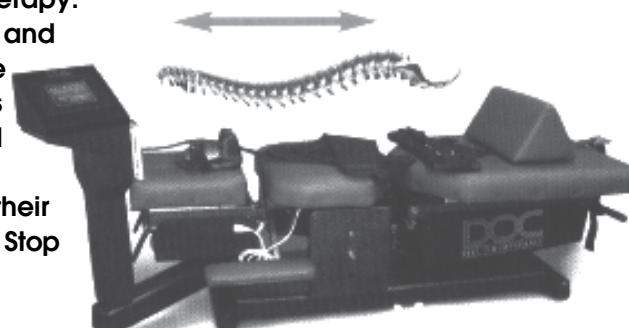

## Kenzie MacNeil Passes Away Suddenly

One of Cape Breton's music entertainers passed away suddenly last week. Kenzie MacNeil is best known for his composition The Island which he wrote and recorded in the 1970s.

MacNeil was an early performer in The Rise And Follies which featured well known Cape Breton artists presenting original music and comedy sketches. It was the precursor of the Cape Breton Summertime Revue and a venue for developing new talent.

Kenzie had a career in songwriting, acting, producing, directing, and writing for films, television, and radio for over forty years. Kenzie inherited his love for family, music, and community from his parents, John Angus and Anastasia (Borden) MacNeil.

Centred around the College Pub, a close group of the Island's greatest talents came together and formed the heart of the cultural renaissance of Cape Breton in the 1970s: poetry readings, plays, revues, skits, open mics, festivals - all of which laid the path for the Boardmore Playhouse and put Cape Breton story and song on the national stage.

MacNeil also threw his hat into the political arena and ran in the Sydney-Victoria federal riding in 2004 and 2006 elections and again in 2019 as an Independent candidate.

In addition to his musical talents, Kenzie was editor and publisher for many years of The Cape Bretoner Magazine and worked for the provincial Department of Economic Development.

He will be sadly missed and remembered for his contribution to the music and comedy development in Cape Breton.

On his beautiful 12-string Guild guitar, he composed songs such as "Johnstown Boogie," "The Bungalow," "Stubborn Spruce," and "The Barbarian. Kenzie MacNeil was 68.

Thankfully one thing that the pandemic didn't do was keep a total lid on album releases (some were delayed though-and in this case this album was finished, but the release was delayed) so seeing the return of one of the best second generation punk bands ever (California's Holy Trinity being The Offspring, Green Day and Rancid) was a treat for my ears. It's been 9 years since The Offspring graced our musical palates with tasty morsels of mainstream punk songs that often times had a real spiciness to them-helping the band sell over 40 million records, make some awesome music videos and really bring punk rock into the commercial mainstream. So this is "Let The Bad Times Roll". To kick things off the politically-charged kick ass track "This Is Not Utopia" gets the ball rolling on the demented state of affairs south of the border, but the romper-stomper track "Coming For You" was the first single released-and the YouTube video shows us that lead singer Dexter Holland, guitarist Noodles, drummer Pete Dinklage and bassist Todd Morse are as punk today as they were 37 years ago. My favourite song here is "Let The Bad Times Roll", it's the closest one to the band's early



days sound. My all-time favourite Offspring song is "Gone Away"-a song about the loss of a loved one, and how trying to just get from day to day can crush your soul. To hear Dexter rework the song as an acoustic number here with him at the piano is so magnificent that this number alone makes this album worth getting. As for the other songs on the album, "Army of One" is like an adrenaline rush from chugging 8 cups of coffee, "Coming For You" is a great number with a toe-tapping beat (in a pair of Doc Martens that is) and "We Never Have Sex Anymore" has a big band vibe with a real tongue-in-cheek naughtiness. The album also features 2 covers; "Hassan Chop" is from the Bugs Bunny/Daffy Duck cartoon that was voted one of the best cartoons ever by animators, and unbelievably classical composer Henrik Ibsen's "In The Hall Of The Mountain King" (from the 1867 play "Peer Gynt") is presented with a thousand miles per hour-downhill sound. All in all-this is an amazing album.

## Summer Fire Safety Tips

There is so much to do during the warmer weather. For this reason, it is critical to keep these summer fire safety tips top of mind while you enjoy yourself.

### PROPERTY FIRE SAFETY TIPS

Maintain 10 feet of space between your home, shed, and any fire pits, bonfires, or tiki torches.

Supervise children and pets at all times, especially around open flames.

Keep matches and lighters far out of the reach of children.

Put out any open fires before leaving the backyard or going to bed.

Leave fireworks to a professional.

### GRILLING FIRE SAFETY TIPS

Never grill indoors.

Situate the grill away from the home, deck railings, roof eaves, and low branches

Check propane hoses for leaks before using.

Open the lid of your gas grill before lighting it.

Only use charcoal starter fluid on charcoal grills. Wear short sleeves or roll up sleeves while cooking.

Use long-handled grill tools to avoid burning your fingers and hands.

Keep the grill at least 10 feet away from the property.

Maintain 3 feet of space between children, pets, and the grill.

Never leave the grill unattended.

Clean leftover fat and grease off the grill to prevent fires.

Allow any coals to fully cool before placing them in a metal container for disposal.

### PREVENT BURNS AND FIRES THIS SUMMER

By utilizing these summer fire safety tips, you can decrease the chances of a fire or being burned by one. Should you have a mishap, run any burns under cool water for 3-5 minutes before covering with a clean, dry cloth. See a doctor for any severe, large burns.
