



Take 2 DIRECTOR WITH PAUL POWER

An important part of 'Canadiana' is our music-and Murray McLauchlan is definitely one of our elder statesmen. Since releasing his first album in 1971, he has chronicled part of the Canadian experience with amazing songs such as "Whispering Rain", "Farmer's Song" and "Down By The Henry Moore". After 18 albums and over 50 years in the music business Murray returns to the spotlight with his latest album "Hourglass". 


