





I wrote my first review of The Mahones way back in 1999 for the band's "The Helllfire Club Sessions" album, and for everything they've done since then-so I am familiar with bandleader Fintan 'Finny' McConnell's music. After 30+ vears on the scene it's about time that Finny released a solo album-one that was recorded in a 'live off the floor' fashion that adds a fresh approach to the end result. Most people are used to a totally 'in your face' delivery from The Mahones, but this outing will come as a bit of a nice surprise, and the collection is a mix of original numbers and cover songs. As I read the liner notes and saw Finny's thank you list to musical mentorswhich started off with Joe Strummer, The Clash and The Dubliners I knew this was an album for me. The album opens with Finny's haunting take on Bruce Springsteen's "Atlantic City". It's intense yet intimate at the same time-and you can tell here that Finny's a big fan of The Boss. The military style drumming and tin whistle on The Pogues "A Pair Of Brown Eyes" help lift Finny's vocals right up there to the original version by Shane MacGowan. This is a great track. Continuing on, Finny's delivery of Lou Reed's



"Pale Blue Eyes" is fragile, emotional, delicate and beautiful. The more uptempo tracks here are "Cocktail Blues", with it's smooth rockabilly scat vibe, and "We're Miles Apart" is a song I can imagine Bruce Springsteen singing; it also has a Graham Parker feel to it. The original song "New York City" is a straight-on bare bones rock number that is fantastic. For some more original songs, "So Far Away" and "Someone Save Me" are great numbers and "Stars (Oscar Wilde)" tells the tale of a Catholic boy from Dublin, and the hardships he faced. This song is a 10 out of 10. The album 'officially' closes with what to me is a real surprise; the Tragically Hip's song "Fiddler's Green" is stripped bare, with only a guitar as back-up to Finny's amazing vocals. The bonus track here "Back Home" and is Shane MacGowan's favourite song by Finny; the musical bond between both of them flows through this number. All in all, this is a fantastic album.

The North Sydney Historical Society seen a posting on a social media site that some cities and towns throughout Canada are honouring their town heroes with a "Banner project". We were very interested with the idea as soon as we seen it said Historical Society Chairman Joe Meaney. We knew if we were going to get the project off the ground we would need the local Legion and Fire Department on board said Meaney.

I approached the Legion and Fire Department both which I'm a member of said Historical Society Treasurer Harry Taylor. They were both very receptive and eager to participate. The Banner Project means there will be Banners with pictures of North Sydney Veterans, their picture, name and regiment on the banner displayed in the downtown of North Sydney on poles between Regent and Blowers St. This year is the first year and we were in a time crunch so we asked the CBRM if we could use the 15 banner brackets that they have there banners on now.

They accommodated us and we will be hanging 15 banners up around the Thanksgiving Weekend and they will be left up until after Remembrance Day. Carl Wall, President of Branch 19 in North Sydney added it is a great way to honour our veterans and this will be just the beginning because we see the project growing over the next few years. We appreciate the Historical Society coming to us with this idea Wall added. Legion member Vince Penney also echoed President Wall and Chairman Meaney in saying it is such a worthwhile undertaking especially as we owe our freedom to our Veterans.

Penney also suggested that the names of the deceased veterans that are on the cenotaph also be done on the banners. Harry , who is the lead on the project said Meaney, has been working hard getting the first 15 names and would like the public to know that if you would like to submit a veteran to be on one of the banners for next year or want info on the project please feel free to call the museum office at 902-794-2524 and leave your name and phone number and we will return your call. In 5 or 10 years time we'd like to see a veteran on every pole in North Sydney Taylor said.
