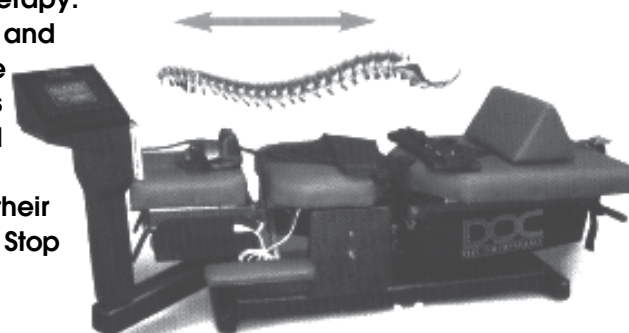

And of course, when they did that movie, they took the full fireman's course.

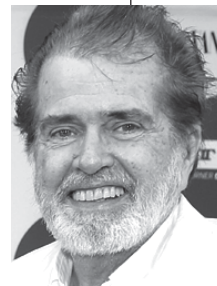
Travolta is finishing up a movie with actor Bruce Willis called "Paradise City" then he'll also be starting another one called "In Character" and he starts that in October.

For this week's column I was going to write about another subject-but something unusual, creative and intriguing caught my eye in a big way. To step back a bit, I am a big fan of Canada's own Annie Murphy and her work, especially on "Schitt's Creek"; she perfected playing a likable ditsy bubble-head, but there's so much more to Annie's acting skills. For years she was a struggling actress and recounted in 2020; "My house had just burnt down, I had like, \$3 in my bank account, I hadn't worked in close to two years. And I had just blown my very first screen test — like blown it, blown it, blown it. ... I found myself crying in the Pacific Ocean, a very snotty cry, and the universe was like, 'Don't do this anymore. This is not for you!' But then, two days later, I got the audition for "Schitt's Creek" (in 2013) and the rest is history-or the future, depending on how you look at it. Now to the main subject: "Kevin Can F**k Himself" is a dark comedy running on AMC that is like no other show I have ever seen. It follows Annie's character as she tries to deal with a totally insensitive man-child husband and an unhappy marriage. Here's the ringer; as the wife the segments are



shown in a typical sitcom style, complete with a laugh track, bright colours and supporting characters that are stupid. Then it cuts to Annie's character in her 'real' life-one that is definitely not funny, and is dark and claustrophobic. Imagine "The Sopranos" meets "The King of Queens" and that description is dead on the mark. As of writing this I am halfway through the first season's 8 episodes (AMC has renewed the series) and I am almost ready to binge watch and show-verdose. The Rotten Tomatoes website said; "an ambitious blend of genres don't always gel, but searing social commentary and a stellar performance from Annie Murphy make for an engaging watch." Annie IS this show, and I think it's her best work ever. This is indeed not a series for everyone-but if you want a fresh, intelligent viewing experience and are willing to step away from the dumb cookie-cutter sitcom premise then this is the show for you. Enjoy!
