





### **Background For The Reconciliaton Holiday**

For the first time, Sept. 30 will mark the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation.

In June, Ottawa declared it a federal statutory holiday that is meant to give public servants an opportunity to recognize the legacy of residential schools.

The designated paid holiday for federal employees also addresses one of the 94 calls to action from the Truth and Reconciliation Commission: "We call upon the federal government, in collaboration with Aboriginal peoples, to establish, as a statutory holiday, a National Day for Truth and Reconciliation to honour survivors. their families, and communities, and ensure that public commemoration of the history and legacy of residential schools remains a vital component of the reconciliation process."



Sometimes it's not a good idea to read too much about a movie in advance-in the case of the "Candyman" sequel I read a lot in Rue Morgue magazine on the preproduction, which built up my expectations. I will admit to being a big fan of actor/ filmmaker Jordan Peele's work in the horror genre: the movies "Get Out" and "Us" were great and his reboot of "The Twilight Zone" series in 2019 and 2020 were a personal favourite of mine. Jordan is of mixed race descent and he deserves much credit for providing great opportunities for black people in front of-and behind the camera, especially for Nia DaCosta to direct this film. Given all that I do have to say that I was disappointed with this movie. It did start off with a lot of promise-how painter Andy MacCoy (played by Yahya Abdul-Mateen) finds a new muse in the Candyman legend, and the events surrounding the Cabrini Green housing project in Chicago and gentrification of inner-city neighbourhoods. This is what Andy needed to kick-start his stalled career. Then obsession becomes possession. As with most horror movies, graphic violence is the evil twin to horror and this film does indeed have



much of that-but not in a gratuitous way, it fits with the violent nature of the Candyman legend. The use of old-fashioned shadow puppetry to tell the tale of Candyman's origins was a great idea and it was good to see Vanessa Williams, Tony Todd and Virginia Madsen reprising their roles from the original movie, but alas even they could not keep this movie on-track. I found that the steam just fizzled out around the halfway mark and although the camera was in focus my interest in the film was not. It degraded into a stylistically pretentious exercise in 'how cool we are' where the backbone of what makes a horror film great gets lost in the blood and visceral violence. I am sure that a number of people will enjoy this film, but for me maybe reading so much advance press for the movie led to greater expectations. I will certainly not be saying "Candyman" 5 times whilst looking in the mirror.


