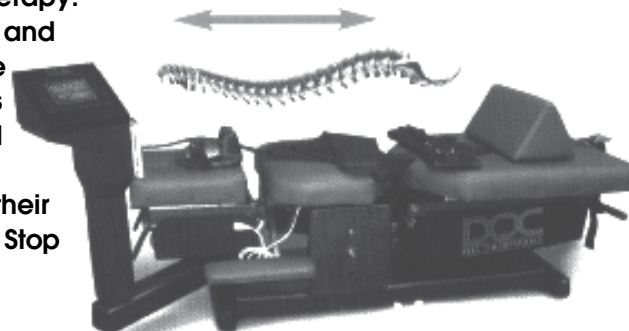

LEAVE IT TO BEAVER

partying, partying and more partying. What also emerged was the depth that each character has, or doesn't have-with Harold (the Scotsman) coming out in the end as the nicest, and the one who changed the most. Extra characters came and went throughout the series but the introduction of 40 year old Dutch student Sabine to the fold made for some super-funny and awkward moments, especially when she had a fling with Harold. The series can be found on Amazon Prime-and some people might think it's daft to watch a TV show filled with mostly despicable people (they obviously never heard of "Seinfeld"?) but there's some redemption for the characters that deserved redemption-the others just didn't really get to hop along their merry way down the street in the end, not having changed into better people. NORTH SYDNEY FIRE & RESCUE HEATING SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

There is something about the Winter months and curling up with a good book by the fireplace. But did you know that heating equipment is one of the leading causes of home fire deaths? With a few simple safety tips and precautions you can prevent most heating fires from happening.

Be warm and safe this Winter!

- Keep anything that can burn at least three-feet (one metre) away from heating equipment, like the furnace, fireplace, wood stove, or portable space heater.
- Have a three-foot (one metre) "kid-free zone" around open fires and space heaters.
- Never use your oven to heat your home.
- Have a qualified professional install stationary space heating equipment, water heaters or central heating equipment according to the local codes and manufacturer's instructions.
- Have heating equipment and chimneys cleaned and inspected every year by a qualified professional.
- Remember to turn portable heaters off when leaving the room or going to bed.
- Always use the right kind of fuel, specified by the manufacturer, for fuel burning space heaters.
- Make sure the fireplace has a sturdy screen to stop sparks from flying into the room. Ashes should be cool before putting them in a metal container. Keep the container a safe distance away from your home.
- Test smoke alarms at least monthly.

HEATING EQUIPMENT SMARTS

Install wood burning stoves following the manufacturer's instructions or have a professional do the installation.

All fuel burning equipment should be vented to the outside to avoid carbon monoxide (CO) poisoning.

Install and maintain CO alarms to avoid the risk of CO poisoning. If you smell gas in your gas heater, do not light the appliance. Leave the home immediately and call your local fire deptment or gas company.

TAX TIPS COLUMN

CANADA EMERGENCY WAGE SUBSIDY CEWS Accounting Treatment

The wage subsidy, because it is related to a non-capital item, may be:

- * netted with expenses (i.e., used to reduce wages expense),
- * shown separately as a deduction from aggregated expenses, or
- * shown as revenue, either separately or under a heading such as "Other income".

For private corporations, see the EY information Understanding ASPE Sections 3800 and 3805, Government Assistance and Investment Tax Credits.

For corporations using International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS), the accounting treatment is the same as with ASPE. See Grant Thornton IAS 20 COVID-19: Government grants.

However, the timing of the recognition of the wage subsidy is as legislated by the Income Tax Act, as noted below.

Be sure to check with your Tax Specialist who can maximize your deductions, especially this year with COVID tax items.
