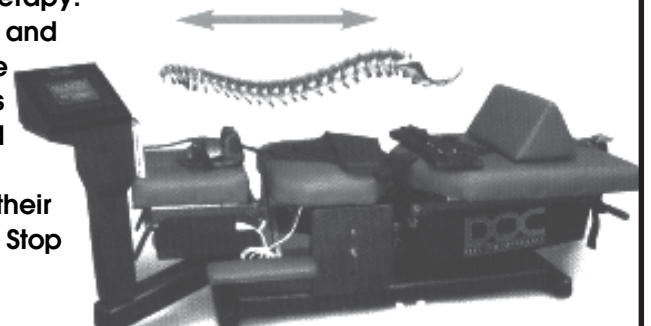

## Fire Prevention Week Safety Tips

The National Fire Protection Association® (NFPA), the official sponsor of Fire Prevention Week for 99 years, has announced Learn the Sounds of Fire Safety as the theme for Fire Prevention Week, October 9, 2021. From beeps to chirps, this year's campaign works to better educate the public about the sounds smoke alarms make, what those sounds mean, and how to respond to them.

Smoke alarms have played a leading role in reducing fire death rates over the past 40 years, but we still have more work to do in maximizing their effectiveness, said Lorraine Carli, NFPA Vice President of Outreach and Advocacy.

According to the latest NFPA Smoke Alarms in the U.S. report, working smoke alarms in the home reduce the risk of dying in a reported fire by more than half (55 percent). However, almost three out of five home fire deaths occur in homes with no smoke alarms (41 percent) or smoke alarms that failed to operate (16 percent); missing or non-functional power sources, including missing or disconnected batteries, dead batteries, and disconnected hardwired alarms or other alternate current (AC) power issues, are the most common factors when smoke alarms fail to operate.

When the smoke alarms in your home beep or chirp and you can't figure out why or how to make them stop, it can be frustrating. All too often, that frustration leads people to remove the batteries from their alarms or dismantle them altogether, said Carli. These actions place people at serious risk in the event of a home fire.

This year's Fire Prevention Week theme, Learn the Sounds of Fire Safety, helps people better understand the reasons smoke alarms may sound and the know-how to effectively address them, helping ensure that smoke alarms remain in working order. The campaign also addresses special considerations for the deaf and hard of hearing, along with information about carbon monoxide alarms.

Giving people the tools to properly respond to alarms sounding whether it's an actual fire or simply time to change a battery can make a life-saving difference, said Carli.

Key messages for Learn the Sounds of Fire Safety include: When a smoke alarm or carbon monoxide (CO) alarm sounds, respond immediately by exiting the home as quickly as possible.

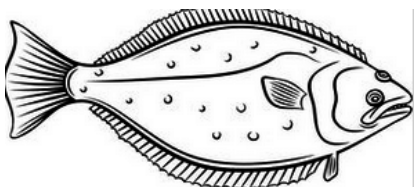
If your alarm begins to chirp, it may mean that the batteries are running low and need to be replaced. If the alarm continues to chirp after the batteries are replaced, or the alarm is more than 10 years old, it is time to replace the alarm. Test all smoke and CO alarms monthly. Press the test button to make sure the alarm is working.

If there is someone in your household who is deaf or hard of hearing, install bed shaker and strobe light alarms that will alert that person to fire.

Know the difference between the sound of a smoke alarm and a carbon monoxide alarm three beeps for smoke alarms, four beeps for carbon monoxide alarms.

This gentleman is certainly no stranger to these shores; Newfoundland's Sean McCann spent 17 years as a member of Great Big Sea spreading their brand of Celtic folk music around the world, and releasing over a dozen great albums. Since leaving GBS in 2013 Sean put out 5 solo albums, with this being album number 6. **"Shanty Man"** starts off with the Celtic rocker "Shantyman's Life", and it has hints of the song "Foggy Dew" dripping off this great track. As the album name alludes to, there are 4 songs here with the word sea in the title; appropriately "Rolling Sea" has a nice Jamaican reggae vibe to it and "Go To Sea No More" walks a more traditional path. I swear I can hear Peter Gabriel's vocal shadow on the wonderful yet sorrowful "Deep Blue Sea", and "Lonesome Sea" is a joyously uplifting romp. There are also some great 'heave away' numbers with "On The Water", "Fire Down Below" and "10,000 Miles Away" all guaranteed to have the feet stomping and hands table thumping. The Reggae vibe pops up again on the chanting "Chariot", as Sean sounds totally at home on this number that reminds us of our nautical links to the West Indies and points beyond.



Sean McCann released a book in 2020 ("One Good Reason") detailing his alcohol addiction, coping with being sexually abused by a priest and how he and his wife pushed through the darkness to find a new beginning. Then we all got hit with this pandemic, and Sean said; "I spent the last six months making Shantyman to keep myself from going slowly insane in the absence of any live in-person concert interaction. Music is medicine, and I believe it is no accident the shanty has resurfaced now when we so desperately need songs that bind us." McCann was helped out on the recordings by friends Hawksley Workman, Gordie (Big Sugar) Johnson, Jeremy Fisher and fiddler J.P. Cormier. Sean McCann received the Order of Canada in 2020 for his work with veterans, PTSD and other charities. He and his music deserve our respect, and support; you'll not find a better nautical musical ambassador than Sean McCann and "The Shantyman" album.
