


On November 11th, there will be a Remembrance Day Outdoor Service held at the Big Bras d'Or Presbyterian Church Cenotaph.



## **New Urgent Treatment Centre Opens**

It was a busy day Monday for those at the new urgent treatment centre at the Northside Hospital in North Sydney, N.S. The centre opened its doors to the public for the first time Monday morning.

"The phone lines were busy this morning, but people who needed to get booked, got booked," said Dr. Stephanie Langley, one of the family doctor's in the area who is helping staff the new urgent treatment centre.

The new centre was created by the Nova Scotia government as a hybrid between an emergency room and a family doctor's office. Appointments at the urgent treatment centre were full on the first day, with about 20 patients being seen.

"There was a gentleman who fell earlier and had a shoulder injury," Langley said. "Another person had an abscess that needed incision and drainage. So, very appropriate visits to the urgent treatment centre." Gordon MacDonald is an area councillor who has been a vocal health-care advocate in his community.

He says if the province intends to have the same healthcare model replicated everywhere in Nova Scotia, he's happy the North Sydney area was first to try it out.

"There's been a little bit of a buzz going on," MacDonald said. "(But I) hope peoples' expectations are not too big, so they think it's an emergency room, because it's not going to be used for that purpose. But I think for a quick assistance and what we have happening at the Regional Hospital, I think this is going to benefit us."

MacDonald says he's concerned there could be a few problems at first when it comes to meeting patient demand.

hope it's not going to be a replacement for doctor recruitment,"MacDonald said. "People still need their family doctors and I believe the people that are using this urgent care treatment centre will tell you the same thing."

Langley says there is excitement among staff to be the first to try the new model. She adds the plan is to take more patients per day, once staff become accustomed to the new routine.



# Take 2 OIRECTOR WITH PAUL POWER

Even though I drifted away from the music of William Broad over the years I always knew how great an artist he is-of course most people know him as Billy Idol. Billy rose through the ranks of the punk scene in the late 1970's as the lead singer of the band Generation X and then had huge critical and commercial success in the 1980's. He moved away from the limelight in the 1990's a bit-only releasing 4 albums between 1990 and 2005, but did do some acting and made guest appearances though. FYI-did you know that director James Cameron originally had Billy in mind to play the T-1000 robot in "Terminator 2-Judgment day" but a serious motorcycle accident in February of 1990 put Billy out of the picture-literally. So Billy's back with this 4 song EP "The Roadside". The EP starts off with the rock hard driving force called, of all things, "Rita Hayworth"-but a sample of the lyrics says it all; "We're all actors I play you, you play me In this scene of wannabes and abusers 'Cause when the black hits There's no available light left You can't offset the dark with illusions You do rails of blow at the House Soho And say, "Man, this place is so full of



losers" And when you wait at the valet and try to escape You get a, "Come on, " from some nothin' producer". Methinks Mr. Idol is slamming the Hollywood cult of personality machine. "Bitter Taste" is an atmospheric number as Billy's voice goes from low to high on verse and chorus-the song reminds me of something the U.K. Band The Mission, The Doors or Chris Isaac might do. It references Billy's serious accident motorcycle mentioned above. I like this tune a lot. "U Don't Have To Kiss Me Like That" is a throbbing slab of bebop rock that is definitely classic Billy Idol.The EP closes off with "Baby Put Your Clothes Back On"-another song that has a smokey, cool cat groove that seems to be made for Billy's vocal delivery, and also sounds like something Chris Isaac might do. It's not a slam on someone's looks-it has more of a gentlemanly theme. With this being the newest material we've heard from Billy since 2014 it's a great return to the limelight.
