

I'm a big fan of Ed Sheeran's music; he consistently manages to find the perfect balance between writing and performing catchy pop songs with ones that have so much depth and meaning. This is Ed's new album "=" (equals) and I actually watched the album's first single on YouTube in June and fell in love with the number 1 hit song "Bad Habits". It's another great example of Sheeran's skills. and the video is over the top silly and fun. Second up was the song "Shivers", and this one again has that perfect pop vibe with a great beat-however, just before that Ed put out the promotional single "Visiting Hours". This number is a gut punch and I challenge anyone with a heart to not be deeply moved by the song as Ed sings about wanting to talk to a loved one who has passed on. Ed revealed that the single was written about his friend Michael Gudinski (a powerful and significant Australian record executive who's legacy is amazing) whom Ed described as "a father figure and mentor". Cue the Kleenex if you watch the music video. Ed said that for him this is one of the most important songs on the album. The album's actual opening song "Tides" is a rocking guitar driven song



that has Ed singing "I am grown up I am a father now..." but still loving "getting out of my mind" but feels "embarrassed bout the things that I did in my youth/'Coz now I have a child I know one day that she'll go through it." As for some of the other songs, "Love In Slow Motion" is a great number that really has a lot of heart and soul, and "First Times" is very intimate and personal with Ed's actual wedding proposal in the lyrics; "you said Darling are you joking and I said please". He looks back in a melancholy way on an old relationship with the lyrics "the cards were stacked against us both-I will always love you for what it's worth" yet can still show us he doesn't take himself too seriously on "Collide" singing "fumbled in cubicles in Tokyo and been to funerals in rented clothes..we drank your father's whiskey when your grandma died". The album closes with "Be Right Now" as Ed suggests we live in the moment. Great advice from a great album.




In Flanders fields the poppies blow


