





About the album the duo said: "Can't Hold the Light has been a giant undertaking for us, since Golden Hour we traveled basically all over Canada and even down in Nashville writing these songs about life on the road, falling in and out of love, and holding on to happiness in the darkest of times. We've worked with our ever growing team day in and day out to give you a little piece of ourselves, even when there were days we could have given it all up. but there's magic in music and everyone who worked on this record knew we were creating something special." Interestingly enough-this, their third



album actually opens up with the more uptempo song "Hope"-and it highlights just what QTR do so well. The blend of folk, alt-country and light rock finds a perfect home on this number, and the song "Through The Night" is a fullon rocker that allows both Kirsten and Jordan to amp it up and throw caution to the wind. Without describing every song here it's important to mention something like "Home Is Worth The Blues". a song that rivals a lot of what we hear on today's pop/hit radio. This number reminds me of something City and Colour/Dallas Green would do. The song makes us all aware of the fact that home is what justifies the daily grind of the average Joe & Jane, getting to the end of that day and finding that oasis of comfort and love. The album's namesake song, "Can't Hold The Light" is beautiful and "Love You The Best" really offers Kirsten the perfect musical avenue for her subtle and touching voice.
