It's not often that I get to write about a music on doc on a legendary Heavy Metal band that actually played in Sydney Mines in 2019, but here it is: **"The Story of Anvil"**. It would be easy to think that this is a satire, Ala "Spinal Tap", a comedy of errors. Plus, the coincidence that the director of "This is Spinal Tap" was Rob Reiner ("All in the Family" fame) and the drummer for Anvil is Robb Reiner. That's where the similarities end though-this DVD is not a comedic farce; it's real, sometimes too real as the life of Anvil is laid bare for all to see. In the early 1980's Anvil shared the stage with the likes of Bon Jovi and Whitesnake, and influenced bands such as Slayer, Anthrax and Metallica; Lars Ulrich even shows up here to tell us how influential Anvil were to Metal bands-ones that went on to fame and fortune. So what happened to Anvil? Why was fortune and fame so elusive? This feature presents a bunch of normal guys who live and breathe rock and roll and did everything they could to succeed-and it's as if the cosmos conspired against Anvil time after time. As the story progresses the band gets a new manager who defines the word "inept"; getting lost on the way to a gig, or playing before 174 people in a 10,000 capacity



heart and soul of the band is definitely Steve "Lips" Kudlow; even after decades of disappointment and heartache, and doing jobs such as deliveries for a catering company (which he never complains about) Lips is still searching for that "big break"; he's Don Quixote and the windmills are fame and fortune. However, after this doc was released it did so much for the band as they played several festivals, including the Download Festival-headlining the Tuborg stage., opening for AC/DC and Saxon-and sharing the stage with Scott Ian of Anthrax. Also, albums were re-released, a book was written about the band and they were in the movie "The Green Hornet". Blacksmiths work metal on an anvil, which means that the anvil is stronger than the metal; Anvil are indeed stronger than metal because they ARE Heavy Metal, and this rockumentary is forged in that same fire.

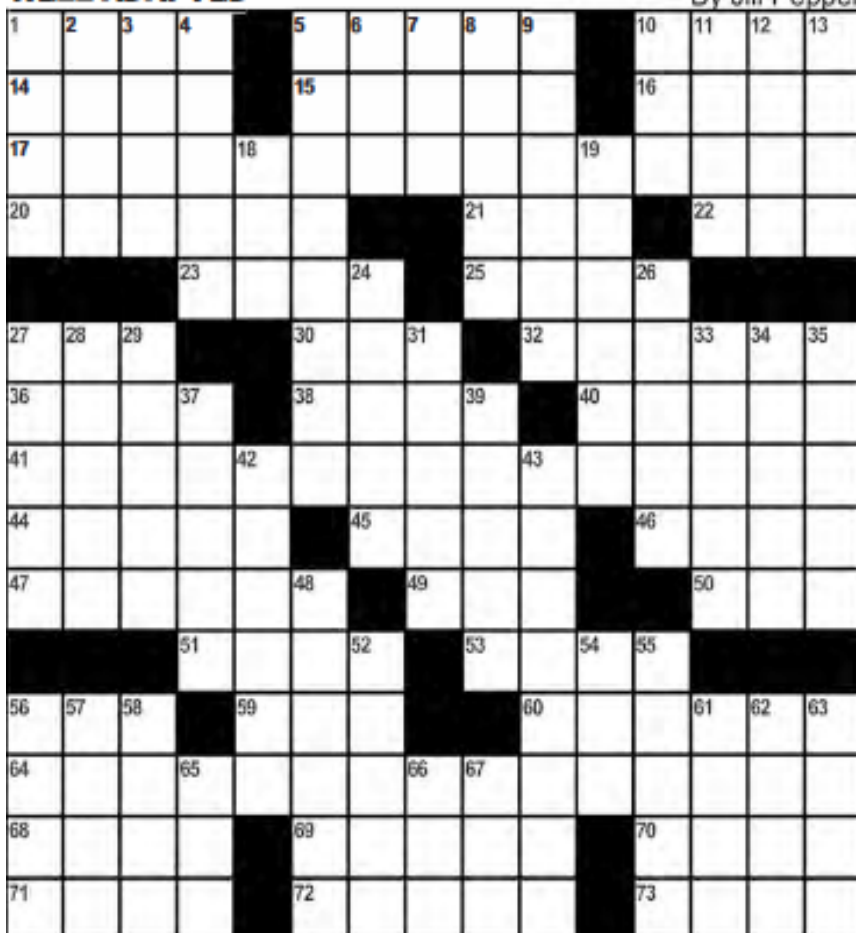

TAX TIPS 2021

TIPS TO AVOID TAX SCAMS

Tax season is a key time for scammers to try and get your tax return. Now that many of us complete our taxes online, be aware that not all contact online is legitimate. BIG TIP see below about CRA contacting you.

File your taxes as early as possible. File before a scammer has the chance to use your information to file a fake return.

Only deal with trustworthy tax preparation services. For many people, major life changes, business ownership, or simply a lack of knowledge about the ever-changing tax laws make finding a trustworthy tax preparer a good idea.

Remember that the CRA **does not** initiate contact with taxpayers by email, text message or social media. CRA emails will never request personal or financial information, PIN numbers, passwords or similar access information for credit cards.

Check out websites carefully. Ensure you access the real CRA website when filing your taxes electronically or inquiring for additional information.

Use unique and complex passwords. Always use unique passwords for your CRA and online banking accounts. Do not reuse the same password for different systems. You increase the risk of scammers gaining access if there is a data breach on another platform that uses the same login details as your CRA account. Create a PIN. Set up a personal identification number (PIN) once you log into My Account on the CRA website or call them and set it up with the help of a CRA call centre agent. This will help to confirm your identity for future calls with the CRA.

Sign up for email notifications from the CRA. This service notifies taxpayers by email if their address or direct deposit information has been changed on CRA records.

These notifications can act as an early warning for potentially fraudulent activity. Act immediately if you have been scammed. If you are a victim in Canada, contact your local police service. If you believe your Canadian Social Insurance Number has been stolen, contact Service Canada.

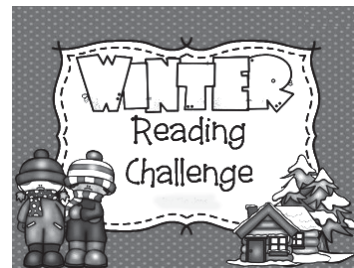

BRETON BREWING TO EXPAND TO NEW DOWNTOWN SYDNEY LOCATION

Breton Brewing has announced plans to expand beyond its original home on the outskirts of Sydney, Nova Scotia, with a location in the city's downtown core.

As reported by Saltwire, Breton co-owners Andrew Morrow and Bryan MacDonald have purchased a building at 278 Charlotte Street that was previously occupied by Oak Hall bridal shop, and will be opening a taproom and pilot brewery.

"We are really excited for the opportunity to add to the amazing culture here in Downtown Sydney," said Morrow in a statement. "We see so much creativity and can't wait to be part of it! While our Keltic Drive location will remain our main manufacturing facility, our new downtown location will expand our reach in many ways."

"We want to bring the welcoming and friendly element of our Keltic Drive taproom to Downtown Sydney," added MacDonald. "This is going to be a space where our brewers will be able to create new and exciting recipes."

No timeline has been given for the opening of the new Breton Brewing location, but details are expected to be announced via the brewery's website and social media as they become available.

Test batteries monthly.

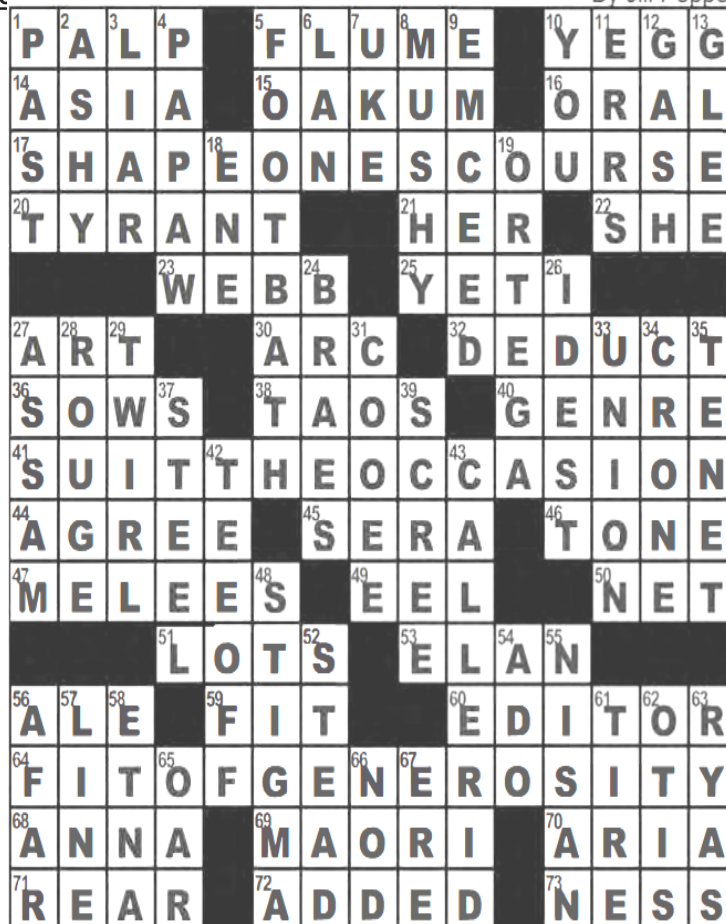
