

On this 10 track album Steve was joined by special guests Dawn Tyler Watson, Crystal Shawanda, Steve Marriner, Jesse O'Brien, Alec Fraser, and Harrison Kennedy-who is featured on the rocking blues single "I Like To Ride". This song pretty much defines what great blues should sound like. There's an amazing old-school vamping groove, almost like a jug band feel on the humourous "Gettin' Stoned". with a great video for the track on YouTube. The song "Hard Luck" reminds me of one of Huey Lewis's harder edged numbers and Crystal Shawanda really brings the

As for some of the other songs, "True To Me" has a Bad Company meets Don Henley feel to it and "Fine Young Man" (with Dawn Tyler Watson) shines bright. Finishing off, "I Don't Miss You", with Harrison Kennedy, has a nice 80's Motown soul groove to it, with Harrison's superb vocals adding that extra touchand the album close out with the amazing song "Love Comin' Down"; I hear hints of Dire Straits. Stevie Ray Vaughan and Chris Rea in the trackwhich all together makes for one hell of a top notch composition. Some featured events will inlcude a Tractor Skills Competition, and ATV Competition and Off Road events and the



This was another expression I often heard around our house and it was usually a negative response to something I would be doing.

There was a great sense of community back then and I often sat around quietly as adults chatted and talked especially around the ball field where they would bring their chairs in the evening to watch the kids play ball

or the men play horseshoes. It was an easy going time and I often picked up neighbourhood gossip that I could exploit to make money.

An example of this would be hearing that Mr. so and so was building a new fence. I would go and offer to paint the fence long before any of the other boys even knew what was happening.

Or the Smiths were getting a new fireplace, I would offer to cut hardwood for them and so on. I always kept my ears open for opportunities.

One of the better suggestions came from one of these discussions. A new car wash was planning to be built and open in a few months time. I thought I'd get a jump on them and painted a sign and set up just on the edge of the playing field.

I got my father to run the hose from our house to the field and he buried it underground using a pick so the cars wouldn't ruin it by running over it. We operated that car wash for many years every Summer.

All the kids wanted to play in the water so we had no shortage of volunteers to wash the cars.

My mother would always say, "Monkey See, Monkey Do" and I would always smile at that because I knew that I would be making money on the adventure.
