

The Camp is based at Knox Presbyterian Church, Ross Ferry (approximately 10 ms. up Kempt Head Road off Highway 105.


The Music Camp is intended as a tribute to the late Brian MacLellan. The mission of the Camp is to expose children to music in a friendly and comfortable environment.
