J Street Community Space Opens Doors

The COVID 19 pandemic has taken a toll on all of our lives. One of the groups affected were our youth. "They were out of school, spending time indoors and away from their friends. This has caused many issues not just for our youth but for everyone. A couple of the biggest issues faced were mental health and social interaction. "Just recently a former youth center responded by opening their doors to provide a safe space for youth as well as providing them with many activities and free meals each day."

The former Johnstone Crescent Youth Center that was

The program once again is under the Association of Safer Cape Breton Communities and Cape Breton Regional Housing and was facilitated by Paul Ratchford.""The staff are various ages and are funded through various summer employment opportunities along with a volunteer administrator Saralyn Gillan. "As I indicated this program offers many free programs along with a free meal each day for youth with a light snack in the afternoon or sometimes a second meal. They also bake fresh daily. From time to time there may be food available to adults but this will be advertised prior to any date available." J Street Community Space is run completely on donations and rely on these to keep the program running. They are also looking for volunteers to help with this amazing program for our youth. 
