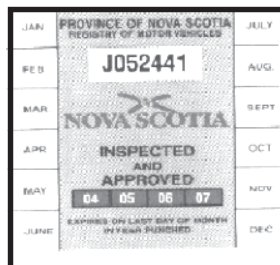

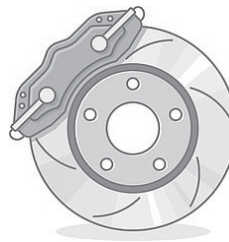

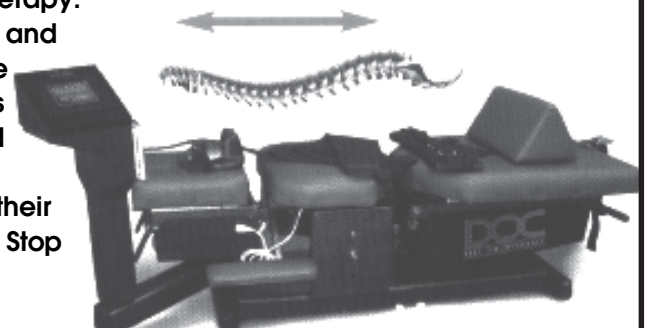

Mr. Bean IS NOT dead. Yes, there were rumours of his demise some time ago but Rowan Atkinson is not only alive and well he just did a great mini-series for Netflix called "**MAN vs. BEE**", and it is a hoot to watch. In a nutshell Rowan's character, Trevor Bingley, is a down on his luck divorced father who is trying to show his daughter and his ex-wife that he can be responsible, so to make ends meet he takes on a job house sitting an incredibly modern and beautiful mansion for a rich couple while they are away. Trevor inadvertently lets a bee into the mansion and that's where the chaos begins, resulting in an all out war between man and bug. To quote an online reference, Atkinson described his character as "different" to Mr. Bean, "much nicer and much sweeter and more normal person" with a "weak spot" of "obsessiveness", compared to Mr. Bean's "self-centered, narcissistic anarchist". Other supporting characters are Trevor's ex-wife, his daughter, a groundskeeper, a policeman and a dog who



poops everywhere if he eats peanuts. The producers actually borrowed the oldest surviving Jaguar E-type from its owner, but created a replica for Atkinson's character to destroy. The replica was later purchased by Atkinson after filming. Another interesting thing about this series is that there are 9 episodes but each one is only around 10 minutes long so it's easy to binge watch in one sitting, if that's your preference. Three sculptures of Atkinson were created and unveiled at St. Paul's Cathedral in London to promote the series and raise awareness for the issues faced by native species of British bees and pollinators. There's a huge plot twist towards the end of the series that makes it even more satisfying-and the actual ending is great. Watching this series will warm your heart and soul-and make you laugh your butt off. It's a honey of a show. Enjoy!

## J Street Community Space Opens Doors

The COVID 19 pandemic has taken a toll on all of our lives. One of the groups affected were our youth. "They were out of school, spending time indoors and away from their friends. This has caused many issues not just for our youth but for everyone. A couple of the biggest issues faced were mental health and social interaction. "Just recently a former youth center responded by opening their doors to provide a safe space for youth as well as providing them with many activities and free meals each day."

The former Johnstone Crescent Youth Center that was opened in



in about 2011 with the Partnership of the Association for Safer Cape Breton Communities, Cape Breton Regional Housing and Bell Aliant and run by the Community Officer of the Cape Breton Regional Police Services. Following this it continued to run under various programs closing the doors in 2020 due to the pandemic. Now it has come

alive again to provide many resources for youth. "There is a new name, activities and staff but the goal is still the same. They arrive to offer a non-judgemental, safe haven with free access to all programs. They also offer memberships of all ages with a goal of changing minds and changing lives." The program once again is under the Association of Safer Cape Breton Communities and Cape Breton Regional Housing and was facilitated by Paul Ratchford. "The staff are various ages and are funded through various summer employment opportunities along with a volunteer administrator Saralyn Gillan. "As I indicated this program offers many free programs along with a free meal each day for youth with a light snack in the afternoon or sometimes a second meal. They also bake fresh daily. From time to time there may be food available to adults but this will be advertised prior to any date available." J Street Community Space is run completely on donations and rely on these to keep the program running. They are also looking for volunteers to help with this amazing program for our youth. They are helping bring our youth back to life after years of the pandemic. For updated information check out their Facebook page.

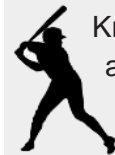

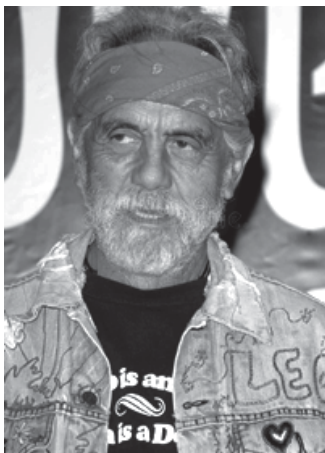

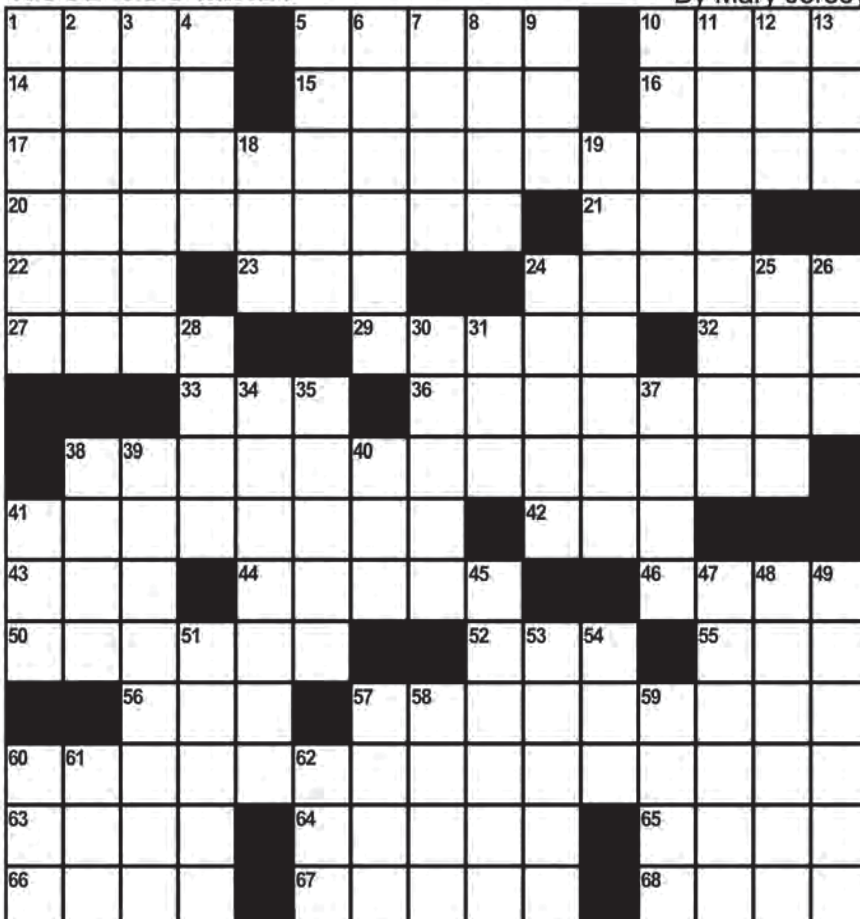
