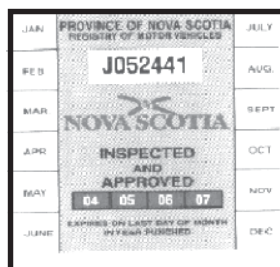

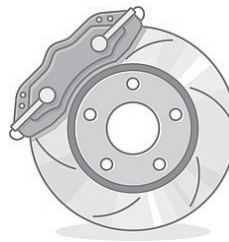

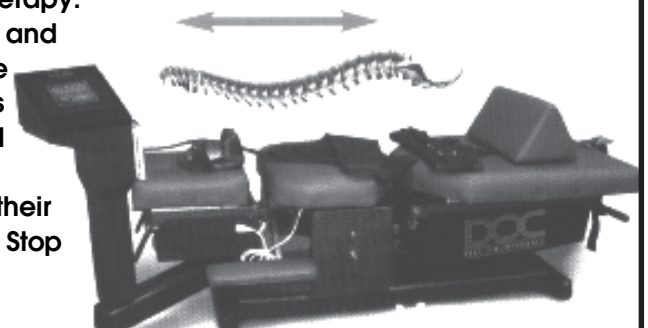

When I first heard of the film "Black '47" I thought of the great Irish band with the same name. The film's title refers to the year 1847, when starvation, plague, disease and death lead to the biggest decrease in Ireland's population during the entire Great Famine (1845 to 1849). Those who survived, and could afford to, emigrated to "the Americas". The movie was filmed in Wicklow, Kildaire, and Connemara (places I visited and loved) in November & December to get a dark, bleak, cold and miserable look. The gist of the film is that actor James Frecheville plays Irish Ranger Martin Feeney, who was fighting for the British army; he abandons his post to return to Ireland, only to discover that his mother has died of starvation, and before that his brother was hanged after stabbing a bailiff when the family was evicted from their home. Feeney finds lodging with his brother's widow and her kids, but when the landlord and the Royal Irish Constabulary comes to kick them out there's a struggle with Feeney's nephew getting shot and killed, and Feeney is arrested. He escapes jail, but only after killing every captor who stood in his way. What follows is Feeney's justice as he goes "medieval" on any person he feels is responsible for his family's woes, not even judge or preacher are safe. The film



also has Hugo Weaving, Jim Broadbent, and Stephen Rea with Weaving as the army investigator tasked with mercilessly hunting down Feeney. His role in the film's ending is a treat for sure. Parts of the movie are in the Irish language (Gaelic) with subtitles. That brogue adds to the authenticity of the story, and Frecheville is masterful at playing a common man pushed beyond comprehension to become a barbarian in the name of revenge and justice. I've seen the Famine Statues in Custom House Quay at the Dublin Docklands, commemorating the famine, the loss of 1 million people to starvation, and another 1 million to emigration, some of whom made it to Newfoundland, here in Nova Scotia and to other provinces, and the U.S. The statues are gruesome, made all the worse knowing they are accurate representations of the event; this movie is also an accurate representation-and a great film.

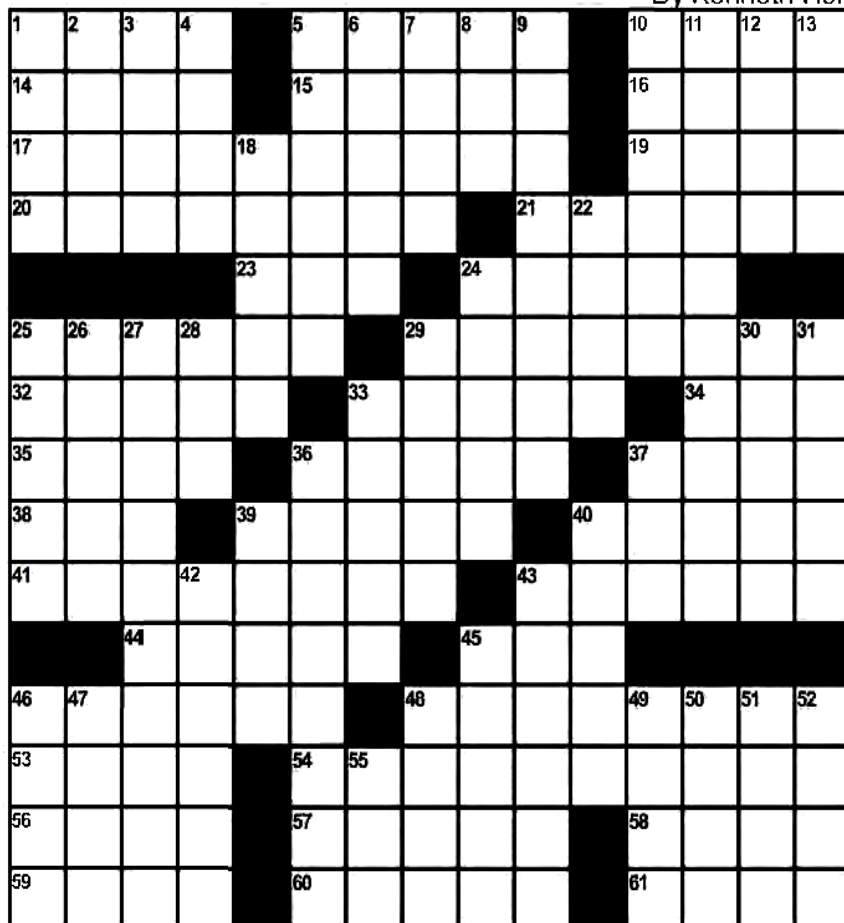
