There's been a lot of attention paid to the Sex Pistols this year-but this film, "**Sad Vacation: The Last Days of Sid and Nancy**", is not for everyone. It is for fans of crime documentaries, music documentaries, and people like me who loved everything about the Sex Pistols. On October 12, of 1978, Nancy Spungen, the girlfriend of Sid Vicious was found dead in room 100 of the Chelsea Hotel, in New York. Nancy was 20 years old. In less than 4 months Sid would also be dead-from a heroin overdose. He was 21 years old. Those 2 tragic events would set off a whirlwind of speculation, and conspiracy theories as to who really killed Nancy. In 1986 director Alex Cox made the wonderfully tragic bio-pic "Sid and Nancy" about the last days of the 'born to lose' couple's tumultuous love affair. This documentary basically does the same thing but with actual footage. Huey Morgan (front man for the band Fun Lovin' Criminals) narrates the film that details Sid's days with the Sex Pistols, and Nancy's questionable life as a New York stripper, a dominatrix and a groupie. It also shows the rough edges of New York City's darker side in the late 1970's-a place custom made for a person like Sid Vicious...and Nancy Spungen. So, some people do believe that Sid was innocent, and that a night of wild partying with others led to Nancy's



murder-most likely while Sid was passed out. Fans of true crime programs will like the way this documentary is laid out. There are interviews with fellow musicians, friends and acquaintances but Sex Pistols lead singer Johnny Rotten (John Lydon) wanted nothing to do with this production. There's 2 striking pieces of information here in the interviews; when band manager Malcolm McLaren asked a band associate how he could get rid of Nancy, to get her away from Sid, the associate said "kill her", and Rockets Redglare (drug dealer and bodyguard for Sid) delivered 40 tablets of Dilaudid to Sid and Nancy the night of her murder. A number of people are on record as saying they think Rockets killed Nancy. This is a great film that does ask the most important question-rather than answer it, but where Rockets Redglare died in 2001 we will never know what the truth is.

Fiona MacGillivray asked our K-LEE RADIO owner and manager Glen Gray asked if she could do an interview promoting a project called The SCHUMAN PROJECT and Glen requested me to do this interview. I was more than happy to oblige. The SCHUMAN PROJECT over the last six months MacGillivray has been composing some material and it's based on the compositions all of the Romantic composer Robert Schumann.

MacGillivray stated in our interview that she always had an affinity for Robert Schumann and what she decided to do is take some of his work and reimagine it with

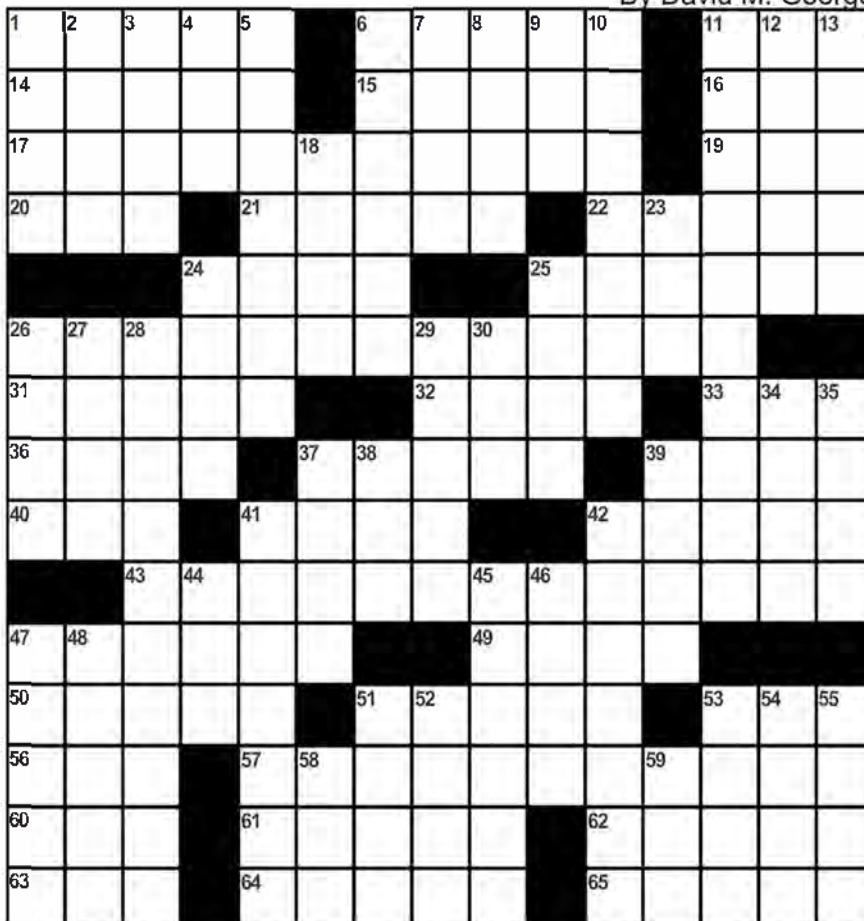
