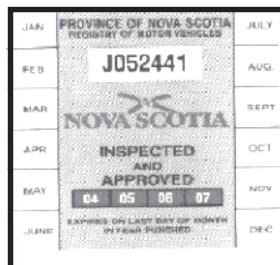

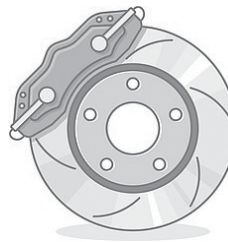

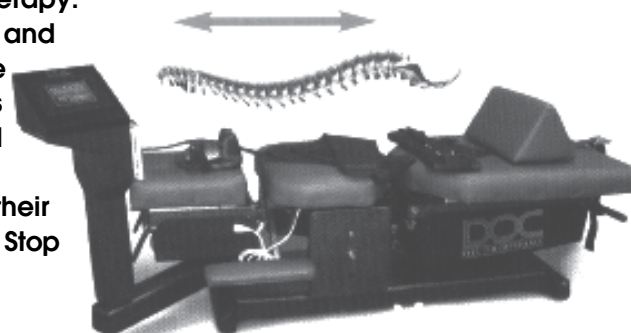

Blue Moon Marquee is a Canadian musical duo, comprised of A.W. Cardinal (vocals and guitar) and Jasmine Colette (vocals and upright bass) who have been together since 2012. Here's a snippet from their bio: "this acclaimed duo writes and performs original compositions influenced by anything that swings, jumps, or grooves. Carving a path through blues, jazz, jump jive, folk, country, swing, and Indigenous soul with an authentic spirit, their sound does not idle easily in one certain category". Interesting words-and this is indeed a very interesting album. The first single released from "**Scream, Holler and Howl**" was the album's namesake song-and a great opener for what's to come. Without mentioning every song, I'll take a few literary snapshots: for instance, "Hound Dog On A Chain" is an excellent showcase for Jasmine's great vocal skills, and two classic blues numbers are given a refresh here too with Lonnie Johnson's "Another Night to Cry" and "Long Black Train", both are delivered brilliantly. My favourite song on the album is definitely "Thick As Thieves", with its similarity to some of Tom Waits material. As for some of the other numbers, "Old Alberta" and "Red Dust Rising" will make you think you just took a sonic time machine back to the dusty, dirty 1930's, and

"Medicine Man" is just downright fun to listen to. A number of the songs have important messages about truth and reconciliation, greed, profits and lies and shady politicians, but are delivered in a non-preachy way that just makes Blue Moon Marquee even classier. Another thing that I like about this album is the fact that it was recorded live to tape, or 'off the floor' as they say. Even most of the biggest name bands out there don't have the guts to do it this way, with overdubs and splicing being the norm. It gives Blue Moon Marquee's songs a more original, natural and organic sound. They had help from Darcy Phillips, Jerry Cook, Matt Pease, Paul Pigat, Bonnie Northgraves, Senor Erik and blues legend Duke Robillard, with Erik Nielsen producing. Duke also played guitar on a number of tracks here, and the legendary Holger Petersen stepped up as executive producer. This is indeed a great album by a great band.

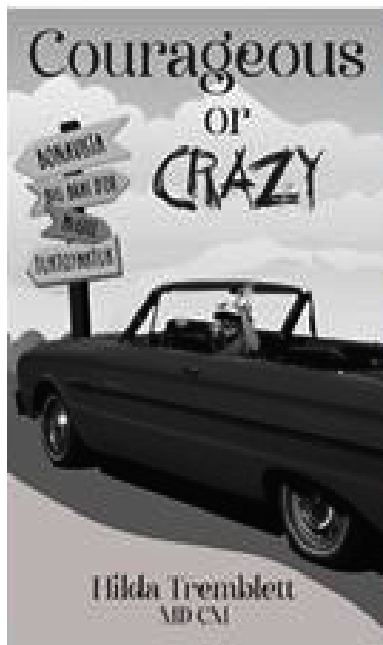

Newfoundland did not join the Dominion of Canada until 1949. Hilda was only 17 years old when she arrived at McGill University in Montreal to commence her undergraduate studies.

She was then accepted into medical school at McGill. From 1964 until her retirement in 1991, Hilda was the pathologist at the Northside General Hospital in North Sydney, NS. To assist young students facing financial difficulties, Hilda has established four scholarships: two at her old high school and two at Cape Breton University. 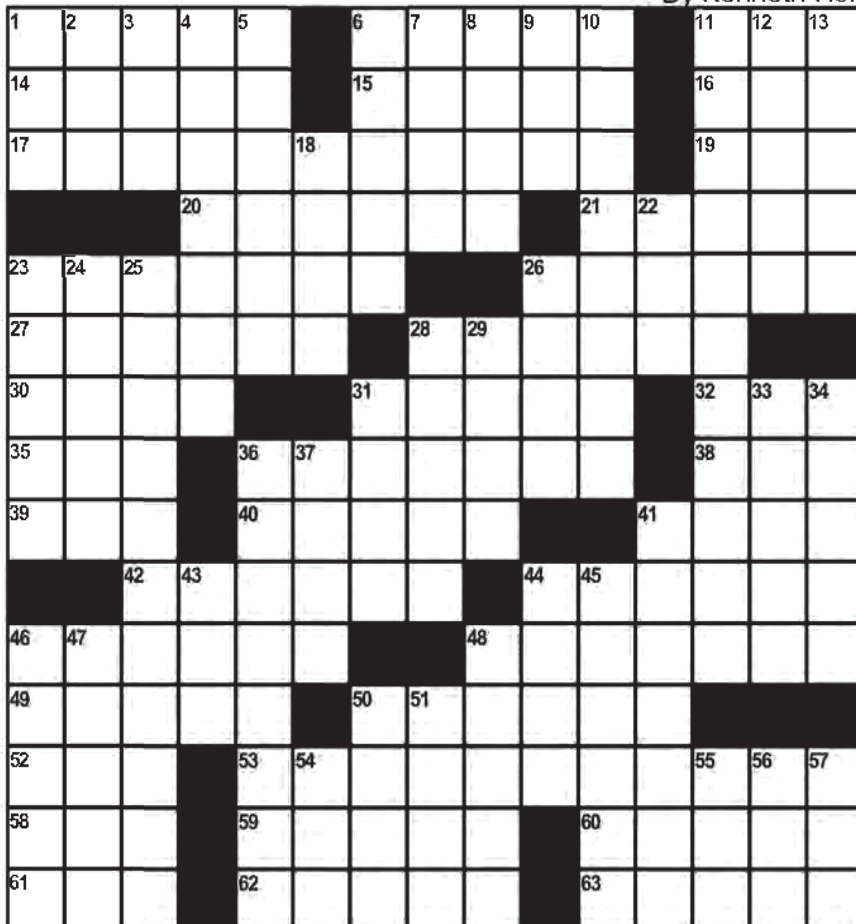
