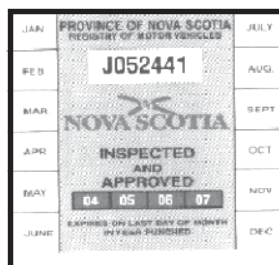

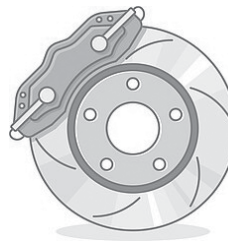

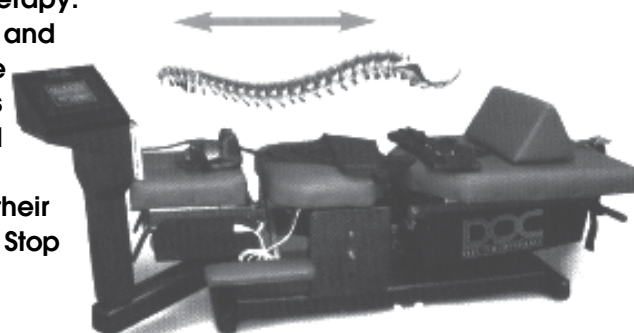

If you're a person that doesn't like spoilers-and plan on watching the movie "Nope" I would suggest you stop reading this right now because this week's column is about that movie-and does have SPOILERS. This film is the latest effort from director/producer/actor Jordan Peele. His background and career thus far would take a number of columns to detail-but let's just say that after successful years in comedy he made a move to the horror movie genre and hit the jackpot; he also said that minority actors will always star in his movies. Peele also waved a magic wand over TV land with his reboot of the "Twilight Zone" series in 2019-2020, bringing a fresh and unique take on what was already an amazing franchise, and he did a great job with the 2017 film "Get Out", but to me with his subsequent movies the bar just kept getting lowered, with "Us" and "Candyman" being the slippery slide down the hill of disappointment. There's been a lot of interest and hype for this movie-and there are a huge number of 'what this or that means' in it, and one was comparing the alien/monster to social media, in that if you don't look up (or at it) you will not be consumed, and the main character didn't look up, and he



survived. There is definitely an interesting note on how the first moving picture was created, by whom, and who was never credited for that piece of cinematic history. I personally think that this film boils down to too many allegories-and not enough substance. The alien/monster starts off looking like a flying saucer with a gigantic anus, and then morphs into what looks like a jellyfish crossed with an angel. Peele also spends so much time using super-wide shots with an accompanying soundtrack that sounds like it was left over from a cheesy 70's sci-fi flick, so much so that one soon gets bored with the forced attempt to create a foreboding feeling, but actually comes across as fore-boring. If I could go back in time and someone offered me this movie I'd say NOPE.

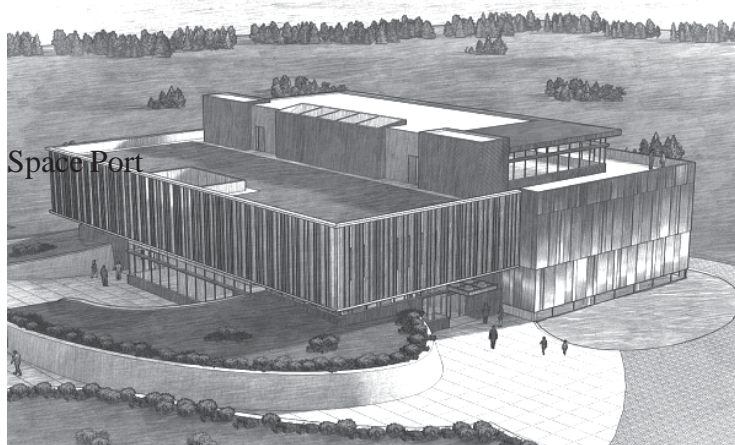

Proposed Spaceport At Canso

Cape Breton is entering the space age with the latest spaceport to be built at Canso. Nova Scotia based Maritime Launch Services will build Spaceport Nova Scotia which will launch satellites into lower earth orbit and the first launch is scheduled for the end of 2024.

The new facility is expected to create well paying jobs in the aerospace industry which is greatly needed in the Canso area.

The Department of Environment and Climate Change has completed its environmental assessment and has given the project the go ahead. There is some opposition from a local environmental group who fear contamination to area from toxic waste materials to be used to launch the satellites.

I'm looking forward to seeing the project completed and I have been to Florida and Cape Kennedy for rocket launches and this could be a step in the right direction for permanent high paying jobs. Construction is expected to begin next year and the first launch will be in 2024. It is expected to have eight rocket launches a year when fully operational.

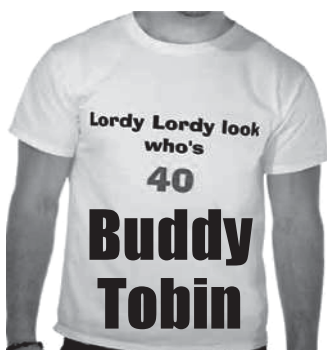
