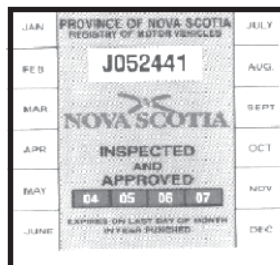

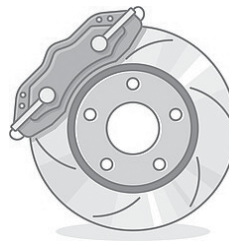

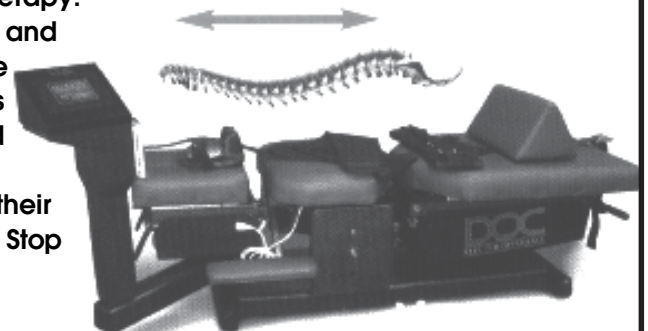

Canada's own Crystal Shawanda is well-known as one of our best blues and country artists, releasing her first album in 2008 that spawned the single "You Can Let Go". The album also reached No. 1 on the Canadian Country Album chart and No. 16 on the Billboard Top Country Albums, the highest charting album by a full-blooded Canadian Indigenous country artist (during the SoundScan-era). She later made a move more towards blues music and this, **"Midnight Blues"** is her eighth studio album, produced by her husband/collaborator Dewayne Strobel. The album's namesake song is a great number, and it's my favourite number here. For the most part this album is original material, but the covers are a real audio treat; Crystal does an amazing version of the Willie Dixon classic "Evil", and surprisingly a Celine Dion song is here too; "That's Just The Woman In Me" is really a pleasant surprise as Crystal and the band breathe new life with a bluesier take on the number. Without mentioning every song, I'd like to give props



to the silky-smooth "Walk With The Moon", which takes the listener back to an earlier day, one that makes me think of a song that Linda Ronstadt might have done. Also, if you're gonna listen to the track "Rumpshaker" you better put your cowboy boots on and get ready to stomp some hardwood floors. Fans of Canadian rock will probably notice how "What Kind Of Man" sounds like a Sass Jordan track-but the song is a Buddy Guy number revamped and vamped up by Crystal. A really nice piano lick opens up the super-cool number "Hold Me", which is another song that lets us hear Crystal's great vocal styling, being an original number that just builds on Crystal's great lyrical and musical resume. There are 10 songs on this album and not one is a 'skip ahead' moment, more like a repeat then move to the next great song. The album is set to hit the shelves this Friday.
