Take 2 with PAUL POWER

With Halloween less than 2 weeks away I thought it would be a perfect time to look at something about one of the original masters of horror-Edgar Allan Poe. This not however adaptation of a Poe story, rather it is actually about Poe himself and what inspired him-or possessed him to write one of his most iconic and terrifying stories; "Raven's Hollow" is a new film that takes place in the fall of 1830 when Poe was a West Point army cadet on a training exercise in upstate New York. Without giving away too much it's safe to say that Poe and his 4 fellow cadets discover something gruesome that leads them to a secluded and mysterious village close by, (Raven's Hollow) a place where the inhabitants do not take kindly to outsiders. While his comrades want to get out of the village as soon as possible Poe sees this as an opportunity to gain valuable experience in criminal investigations, and feels strongly that it's their duty to investigate and solve the crime committed. This is definitely a Gothic style horror film, one that creates dark moods and a sense of



foreboding, but it does indeed have enough story relevant gore to keep the tale firmly set in the horror genre. Although it may be a bit too cerebral for the average run-of-the-mill slasher flick fan it is definitely worth watching, even iust to see something that may have been part of Poe's early life, and how it resulted in a major change/upheaval to said life, laying the groundwork for what followed. I've read a lot of Poe's works (something that can be a bit of a chore for the average reader as Poe's literary styling was firmly set in the mid 1800's) so to see where this film ties in so completely with his classic poem "The Raven" was a treat. Next week this space will be dedicated to the end of a Halloween horror film franchise.
