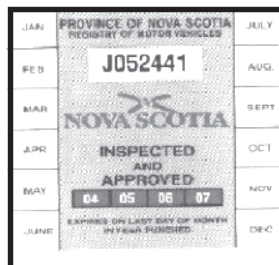

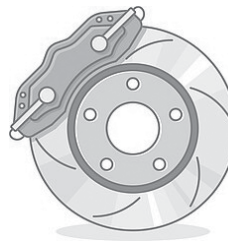

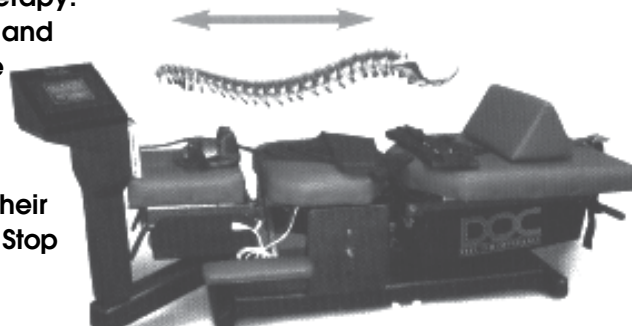

## AROUND THE TOWN



**FIONA** has left its mark on many Cape Breton homes and properties and many homeowners are still at odds with getting help to fix their homes - the hurricane was a direct hit and caused **much more damage** to the electrical system than is normal - the **Provincial government** and the **Red Cross** were quick off the mark to offer timely assistance but a much deeper dive is needed into our community to make certain that our needs are being met - one personal situation arose with a good friend of mine when he was **left homeless** after Fiona damaged the apartment building where he was living - the Red Cross and CBRM stepped in immediately and offered food, clothing and shelter which was greatly appreciated - he was looked after for a month and then **given a deadline** to leave the motel where he was being housed and they couldn't find a place for him to live so they offered him the homeless shelter in Sydney - he would have to leave the building by 10 am, wander the streets of Sydney until 5 pm before he would be allowed to return - is this what we have come to expect of a 77 year old man with diabetes???? - the need for **adequate senior housing** was there before Fiona, but the storm just made it more intense - finding rental properties in Cape Breton is almost impossible to find or to afford for any senior - we need to look at this before the crisis gets any worse..... the annual **Poppy Fund Drive** is underway at all local Legions and you are asked to help support this important fund raising project by purchasing a poppy, a wreath or cross..... the **Isle Aux Morts Boys** are playing, Saturday, November 5, 2022 from 9:00 pm until 1:00 am at Branch 19 Legion in North Sydney...Branch 008 Legion in Sydney Mines is sponsoring a **Jimmy Flynn Night** Friday, October 28.... like many of you, I have a hard time trying to decide what to put on a Christmas card - we solved this problem by giving you a list of appropriate greetings that is available from our website on the **DOWNLOADS** page - [www.kleeradio.com](http://www.kleeradio.com) - **MUNRO CRAFTERS GUILD Annual Sale** - Big Bras d'Or Fire Hall on Saturday, November 5th and Sunday, November 6th..... **Crafts A Plenty** show at the North Sydney Fire Hall, Pierce Street, North Sydney on November 4th, 5th and 6th.... **Moonlight Madness Masquerade** at Membertou - see story opposite for details and date.... til next week, stay safe and have a **Happy Halloween**.

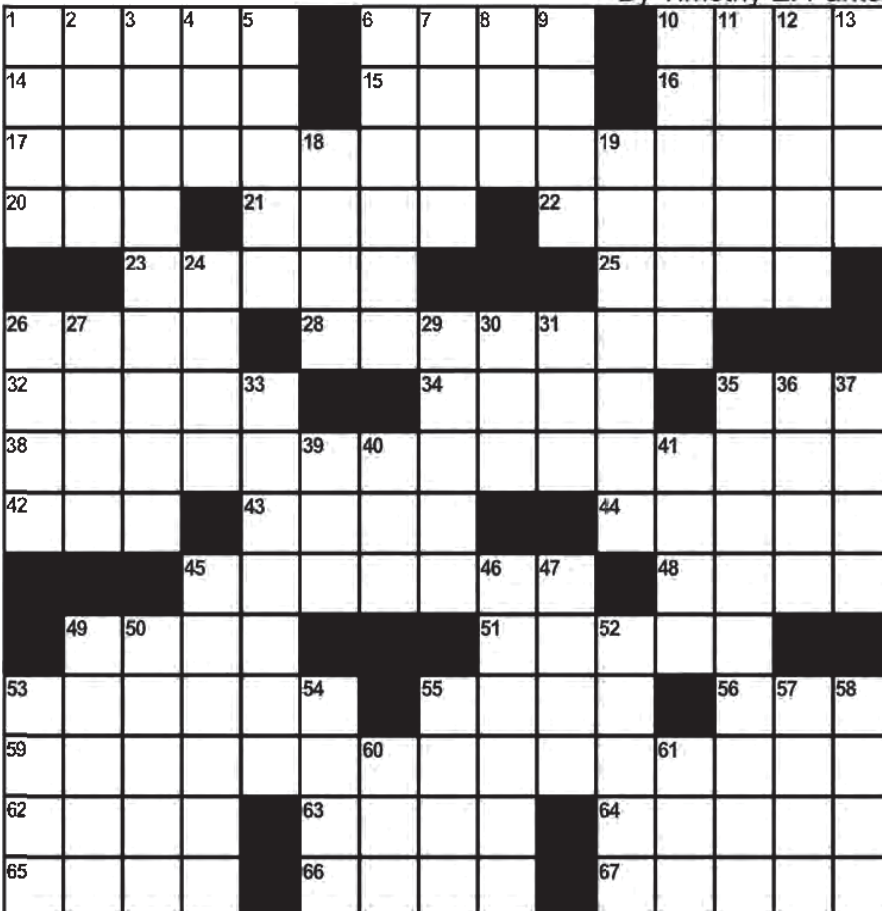
