





For those who don't know, Duke Robillard is a legendary American guitarist & singer who is a master in the genres of blues, swing, jazz and rock and roll and has been performing for over 50 years; he's also released close to 40 albums and guested on dozens more. Duke also founded the legendary band Roomful of Blues, so how's that for a pedigree. This is Duke's latest album release "**They Called It Rhythm & Blues**"; an amazing collection of 18 historic songs that helped chronicle the world of rhythm and blues. Of course for this collection Duke has his own band in tow plus a stellar list of guest musicians including Sue Foley, John Hammond, Michelle Willson and Sugar Ray Norcia to name just a few. The album opens with "Here I'm Is", a great jumpin' jive number filled with a boogie woogie spirit, and the legendary John Hammond drops by on the very traditional "Homeless Blues" and "No Place To Go", which really reminds me of B.B. King's stuff (the song was written by one Chester Burnett, otherwise known as "Howlin Wolf") so you know its a classic number-and the version here is spot on. Duke was also a member of



the Fabulous Thunderbirds, and his old bandmate Kim Wilson joins Duke on the rocking blues song "Tell Me Why" and the down-tempo blues number "The Things I Forgot To Do". These songs are amazing. Canadian blues guitarist/singer Sue Foley brings her chops and string bending skills to the rocking "No Good Lover" and she's also on the instrumental number 'Swingin' For Four bills". For more, the amazing vocalist Michelle Willson hits the mark with the uptempo "Champagne Mind" ("you got a champagne mind with a soda water income") and the down low vibed "Trouble in Mind". With 18 songs on this album space doesn't permit describing them all here-suffice it to say that if a slot machine was musical then Duke and his folks hit a Progressive Jackpot, meaning that the prize increases progressively with every play-just like this CD does.

SENIORS CARE GRANT

The Seniors Care Grant provides financial support to low-to-modest income seniors to help them stay in their homes.

The Grant is an annual grant program to reimburse costs up to \$500 to help cover costs of household services.

It can be used to cover the costs of such things as snow removal, home repairs, lawn care, grocery delivery and more. It is available to homeowners and renters.

To be eligible for this grant:

- * You still reside in your home
- * The property or lease agreement is in your name or includes your name.
- * You are 65 years of age or over
- * You have an annual household net income of \$37,500 or less

All applications must be submitted by May 31st, 2022. You can apply online at

www.novascotia.ca/seniorscaregrant

TAX TIPS

Are You Filing For A Senior?

1. Make sure they file a tax return - Sounds simple, but some folks think that if they didn't earn an income, they shouldn't file a return. Filing always makes sense, because they could be entitled to other credits, deductions and benefits that get triggered once they file a tax return.

2. Split pension income - Seniors are allowed to split up to half of their eligible pension income with a spouse or common-law partner, so they can assign a portion of what they earned throughout the year to their better half. This can mean a significant tax reduction when one spouse has very little income, and the other has a lot.

3. Claim medical expenses - A portion of most medical expenses can be claimed! If your parent is part of a couple and the spouse with the lower income owes any tax, it usually makes the most sense for that person to claim them. Are your parents globetrotters?

4. Claim the caregiver amount - If your parent (or parents) are dependent on you by reason of mental or physical infirmity you may be eligible to claim the Canada caregiver amount. You will need a note from their doctor describing their condition. The Canada caregiver amount is worth \$6,986 less their net income in excess of \$16,405. This means that the amount is reduced to zero if their income is in excess of \$23,391.

5. Split the disability tax credit - If your parent qualifies for the Disability Tax Credit but doesn't have enough taxable income to take full advantage of it, they might be able to transfer an unused amount to you. In order to qualify for this, your parent must depend on you for all or some of the basic necessities of life.

6. Claim the cost of attendant care - If a senior is living in a retirement home and is eligible for the Disability Tax Credit, they can claim the costs relating to attendant care as medical expense.
