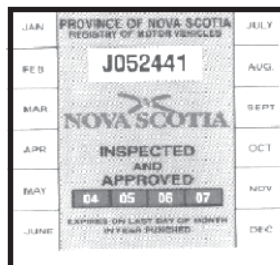

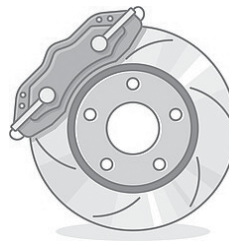

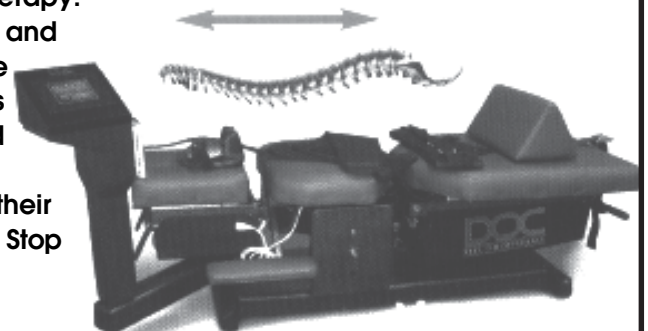

As with last week's column this one is also about a new album release from a band on Stoney Plain; Canada's Roots, Blues, Country and Folk Record label. The Horojo Trio (pronounced as HO-RO-JO, HO - think Santa Claus; RO - Row Your Boat; and JO - Joe) are an energetic award winning Canadian Rhythm and Blues trio featuring drummer Jamie Holmes, singer/keyboardist Jeff Rogers, and guitarist JW Jones. This is their debut album, **"Set The Record Straight"**, and what an album it is! The first track, "Man of Steel", kicks things off in fine style-with hints of Jeff Healey and early ZZ Top on board and the album's namesake song is an amazing old school funky track with a Ceelo Green vibe to it, and "Hard As I Can" slides in on a similar groove. The band's formation came out of a chance jam session, and the band's immediate popularity with audiences shines through here on numbers such as on the album's namesake song, "Set The Record Straight" and I can imagine the track "Hard As I Can" finding a perfect placement on the soundtrack for the movie "The Commitments". As for some of the other songs, old



school blues shine brightly through on "Stay Crazy" and "The Night", and a Robert Cray influence can be heard on "The Running" and "Something You Should Know". After hearing these songs it'll come as no surprise that the band won the 2020 International Blues Challenge (representing the Ottawa Blues Society) which you can see on YouTube, as well as some other great performances from the band in what I think can best be described as an homage to the glory days of Stax Records and the Motown sound-combined with the fresh Horojo Trio sonic experience. The album closes out with the song "Real Deal", and that's exactly what the Horojo Trio are-the real deal and then some. Plus I love the retro album cover. 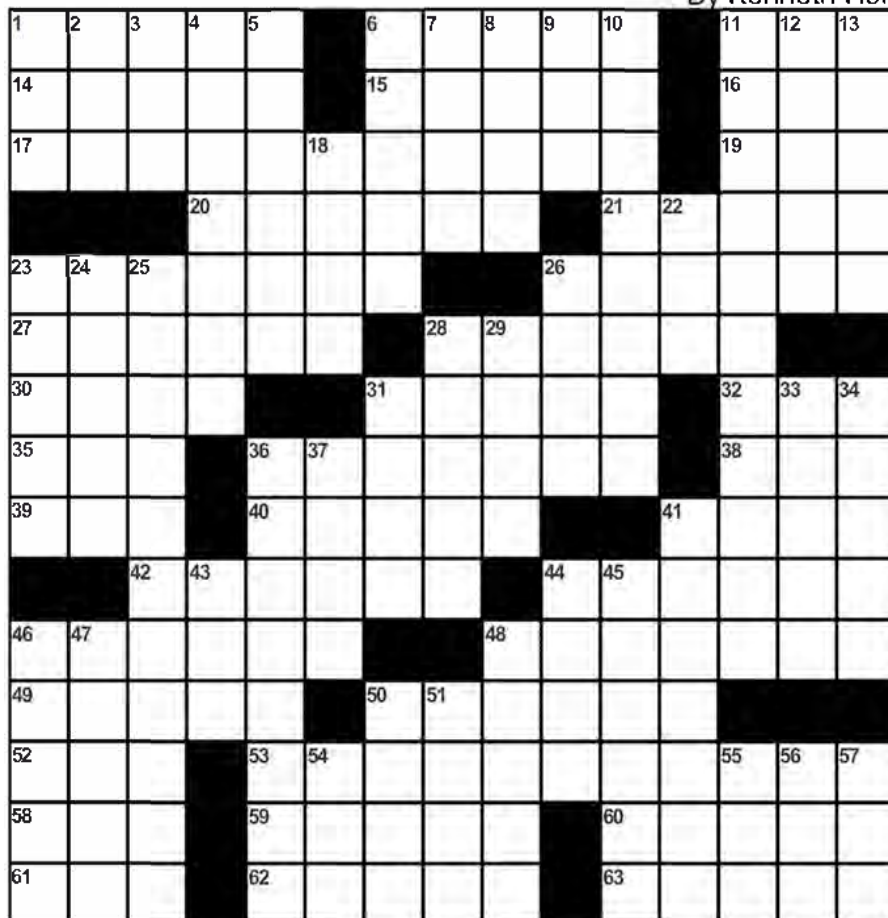

SENIORS CARE GRANT

The Seniors Care Grant provides financial support to low-to-modest income seniors to help them stay in their homes.

The Grant is an annual grant program to reimburse costs up to \$500 to help cover costs of household services.

It can be used to cover the costs of such things as snow removal, home repairs, lawn care, grocery delivery and more. It is available to homeowners and renters.

To be eligible for this grant:

- * You still reside in your home
- * The property or lease agreement is in your name or includes your name.
- * You are 65 years of age or over
- * You have an annual household net income of \$37,500 or less

All applications must be submitted by May 31st, 2022. You can apply online at

TAX TIPS

Do You Qualify For CCB?

To determine your CCB amount, the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) looks at factors like the number of children who live with you, their ages, if they qualify for the child disability amount, and your adjusted family net income.

Over the next few years, your CCB payments will actually be increased! For the benefit periods from July 2022 to June 2023, your benefits will be increased. But keep in mind, your benefits are still based on your income.

Will I receive CCB payments? - In order to be eligible to receive the CCB, families need to meet these conditions:

You need to live with the child, and the child must be under the age of 18

You need to be primarily responsible for the care and upbringing of the child - You have to be a resident of Canada

At least one parent/spouse/common-law partner must be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, protected person, or temporary resident who has lived in Canada for the past 18 months I had a baby but didn't file my return this year. Will I receive CCB payments?

The CRA calculates eligibility in July, and it's based on information that comes from your tax return. In order to qualify for CCB payments, parents need to file their returns every year to start or continue receiving benefits. If an eligible parent doesn't file their return, even if they have no income to report, the CRA can't calculate the correct CCB amount so payments will stop coming in August.

I filed my return late in the year. Will I still receive payments? - if you qualify for the Canada Child Benefit (CCB). This benefit is a tax-free monthly payment from the federal government. It's paid to eligible families to help with the cost of raising children, depending on their household income.
