SENIORS CARE GRANT

The Seniors Care Grant provides financial support to low-to-modest income seniors to help them stay in their homes.

The Grant is an annual grant program to reimburse costs up to \$500 to help cover costs of household services.

It can be used to cover the costs of such things as snow removal, home repairs, lawn care, grocery delivery and more. It is available to homeowners and renters.

To be eligible for this grant:

- * You still reside in your home
- * The property or lease agreement is in your name or includes your name.
- * You are 65 years of age or over
- * You have an annual household net income of \$37,500 or less

All applications must be submitted by May 31st, 2022. You can apply online at

www.novascotia.ca/seniorscaregrant

TAX TIPS

What's my filing deadline?

The countdown is on. The deadline to file most Canadian tax returns is April 30, 2022 but since this falls on a Saturday in 2022, you have until the next business day which would be May 2, 2022. However, you might have a different filing deadline, depending on your tax situation.

WHEN DO I HAVE TO PAY MY TAXES OWING?

If you owe the federal government money this year, the deadline to pay your balance is April 30, 2021 but since this falls on a Saturday in 2022, you have until the next business day which is, good, May 2, 2022. Beginning on May 3, the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) will start adding interest to any amount you owe.

If you're a Québec resident who owes the provincial government money this year, the deadline to pay your balance this year is May 31, 2022. This means Revenu Québec will not add interest to the amount you owe until June 1, 2022.

If you received Employment Insurance (EI) benefits or COVID-19 emergency benefits in 2020 and your taxable income was less than \$75,000, you won't have to pay the taxes you owe until April 30, 2022. Keep in mind, you still need to file your return by April 30, 2021 to avoid late-filing penalties.

I'M SELF-EMPLOYED, WHAT'S MY DEADLINE?

If you're self-employed (for example, if you're a freelancer or a small business owner), your deadline to file is June 15, 2022. If you and your spouse or common-law partner are preparing your returns together and only one of you is self-employed, you can still file both returns by June 15, 2022.

Keep in mind that if you owe federal taxes, your payment is still due on April 30, 2021, and if you owe Québec taxes, your payment is still due on May 31, 2021.

Consult your Tax Preparer to maximize your tax refund.

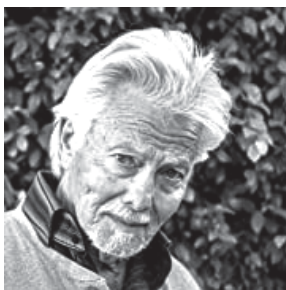

Call Centre Donation To Local Food Banks

There's an old expression, "What goes around, comes around" and it certainly came true this Past Friday.

The Sydney Call Centre donated \$50,000 on Friday to four community food banks. The money was divided equally, with \$12,500 for the Glace Bay, New Waterford and Northside food banks, as well as Loaves & Fishes in Sydney.

Call centre staff came up with the money through payroll deductions and fundraisers.

"For us, it's all about giving back. We were there ourselves three years ago," said Rick Ward, vice-president of operations at the Sydney Call Centre.

Ward was referring to a rollercoaster ride that made national headlines back in December 2018.

On Dec. 6 of that year, the call centre — then owned by ServiCom — abruptly closed, leaving nearly 700 people without a job just before the holidays.

Community members rallied around the employees and their families in the meantime, with donations of food, Christmas presents, and money to see them through.

The choice of the food banks for the big donation was particularly timely. The annual rate of inflation hit 6.7 per cent in March — the fastest year-over-year increase in about 31 years. Charitable organizations have been seeing the firsthand the impact on the people they serve.

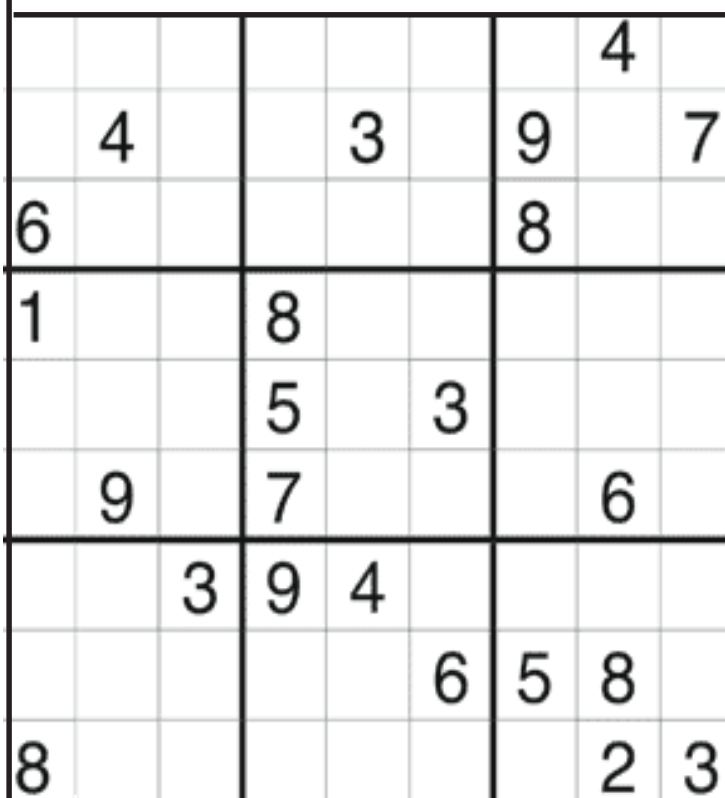
