

For this week I wanted to look back at a release from late last year; my first real listening experience with Billy Bragg's music was when "Talking With The Taxman About Poetry" came out (BTW-love that album title) and how refreshingly original Billy's music was. Billy Bragg was influenced by The Clash and their rock against racism philosophy, thus Billy's future was geared more towards left-wing, or everyday Joe ideology. So 45 years and 12 albums later we have this-"The Million Things That Never Happened". After hearing the first 3 songs here I think it would be fair to say that they could easily fit onto a Bruce Springsteen or a Graham Parker album. As for some of the other songs, "Freedom Doesn't Come For Free is an uptempo folk number about the crazy Libertarian settler experiment in Grafton, New Hampshire in 2004 where the experiment was nixed by, of all things, the bears in the woods! Things then seem to get a bit personal and introspective on "Reflections of the Mirth of Creativity" and "Good Days & Bad Days"; both songs reflecting the fact that most of the album was written and recorded during the lock down in the U.K.. The



album's namesake song somewhat sounds solemn as Billy sings "A father present at a birth, a grandmother hears a first word, a hug for the cryin', a kiss for the dyin' and the million things that never happened at all". At 63 years of age the 'angry young man' shackles may have dropped off Billy's shoulders and it does sound like his songs are more introspective than ever. Interestingly enough though the album's "Ten closing song Mysterious Photos That Can't Be Explained" hearkens back to the younger Billy-with brilliant lyrics like "I've been down rabbit holes, I've seen the rabid trolls cackling in the twilight of the age of reason, one thing I've noticed as I get older common sense, like art, is in the eye of the beholder". To me this is the best song on the album as Billy Bragg lets us hear the fact that he's still vibrant, eloquent and most importantly, relevant.

It's Tax Season once again and we will be running our weekly "TAX TIPS" column to help your prepare your Tax Return for 2021 and maximize the deductions you can claim especially this year with COVID programs - page 6 for details.

## TAX TIPS

#### **COMMON TAX MYTHS**

MYTH #1: If you receive a refund or Notice of Assessment (NOA) after filing, it means you won't be hearing from the government about this return again. Many Canadians believe that the moment they file their return is the moment they can stop thinking about taxes for another year. Be sure to keep all your documents for at least 6 years – the CRA and Revenu Québec can request to see them at any time if your return is selected for a detailed review.

**MYTH #2:** If you've received your NOA, it's too late to change your tax return. If you have the paperwork to support your claims, you can go back up to 10 years to request adjustments to claim credits and deductions you might have missed before. Plus, there's no time limit on adding income to your past returns.

**MYTH #3:** You don't have to worry about information slips that were mailed to the wrong address. No matter where they're sent, you're responsible for your information slips. If you forget to report your information slips twice in a 4 year period, you'll face penalties, and your return will be audited.


**MYTH #4:** If you worked outside of Canada, you don't have to file a Canadian return. If you went to school or worked outside of the country but you have significant residential ties to Canada (such as a home, spouse, or dependants in Canada), you'll need to file a Canadian return.

**MYTH #5:** If you earned less than \$10,000, you don't have to file a return. If you're not reporting much income this year (or even none at all), you should still file a return. Filing your return means getting access to great federal and provincial benefits.

MYTH #6: Tips aren't taxable. One of the most common tax mistakes is not accounting for all the cash you earned (that's right, tips are taxable!). Unclaimed income can result in significant penalties, and information missing from your return can be costly. If you're working in the hospitality industry or get tips through your side gig, make sure you record what you earn and report it on your return.
