





I was going to eventually write about The Poppy Family, as well as other notable Canadian musical acts from the 1970's; unfortunately a loss brings this one forward. Susan Jacks passed away on April 25th at the age of 73. Of course Susan was the voice of The Poppy Family alongside then husband Terry Jacks. For a short time Craig McCaw joined the duo on lead guitar and they added Satwant Singh on tablas. However, in 1970 both musicians were let go and Susan essentially became a solo act with Terry writing, backing and producing. Even with Canadian Content rules being in place for radio since 1971 mandating Canadian content percentages Susan and Terry gave us many great songs over the years. They saw their biggest hits in the late 1960's and early 1970's, as a group and then as solo artists.. Fantastic songs such as "Which Way You Goin' Billy?", "That's Where I Went Wrong", "Where Evil Grows", "Seasons In The Sun", "I Thought Of You Again", "Forever", "Evergreen", "You Don't Know What Love Is", "I Want You To Love Me", "Build A Tower", "Love Has No Pride" and "Anna Marie". Susan hit the charts again with "All The Tea in China" in 1980, and made



numerous appearances on television and live tours over the years. Susan married CFL player Ted Dushinski in 1980 and moved to the States, where Susan continued to write songs and perform. When Ted was diagnosed with lung cancer in 2004 they moved back to Canada; Ted passed away the next year. Susan then suffered kidney failure and in 2010 her brother Billy donated a kidney. From then on appearances were very limited and Susan didn't actually release an album since 1982, however her 1976 album "Dream" was pulled from the market back then but was re-released in 2015. Susan had planned on going back into the studio to record and release a new album in 2018 but her health deteriorated and plans were put on hold. Susan Jacks leaves behind a son, five brothers, a sister and two half-brothers.



It's Tax Season once again and we will be running our weekly "TAX TIPS" column to help you prepare your Tax Return for 2021 and maximize the deductions you can claim especially this year with COVID programs - page 6 for details.

TAX TIPS

Common CRA Scam Telephone Calls

Will the CRA ever call me? - The CRA typically only calls you after they've sent you written communications, such as a letter or a message in a secure CRA portal like My Account, My Business Account, or Represent a Client.

If the CRA does call you, the most common reasons include: You owe money; You haven't filed a return; You're being audited; or the CRA has questions about the tax and benefit records or documents you sent.

How can I make sure that it's actually the CRA? - There are a few things you can do to help make sure that it's actually the CRA who is calling you: Make sure the caller is a CRA employee. Tell them you want to verify their identity before continuing your conversation and ask for their name, phone number, and office location. Hang up and call one of the following numbers to find out if the person who called you was from the CRA: 1-800-959-8281 (individuals) 1-800-959-5525 (businesses)

Once you verify the call was legitimate, you can start talking about what's happening and why you're being called. They won't ask for information about your passport, social insurance number, bank account number, health card, or driver's license. If you get these questions, you'll know it's a scam.

Read (or listen) between the lines. When you're on the phone, the CRA won't use aggressive language or threaten you with an immediate arrest or prison sentence. In addition, the CRA officer will never demand immediate payment by e-transfer, digital currency like bitcoin, prepaid credit cards, or gift cards like iTunes or Amazon.

Trust your gut - If it sounds suspicious, it probably is. If you receive a call or voicemail threatening legal consequences, urging you to call a number other than the official CRA numbers, or if the voice on the other end is robotic, you're more than likely being targeted in a scam. When the CRA calls, it'll be a real person on the other end who you can talk to, not a robot.


