To say that John Mayall is a living legend would be a perfect example of an understatement; for over 60 years John has been part of the vanguard of Blues music and has shared the stage with a litany of other world class blues and rock music masters. For someone who turned 88 late last year it's amazing that John is still giving us music that is so damn good that it almost redefines what Blues music is all about. Unfortunately John announced last year that due to the pandemic and his age he is giving up touring-but may still make some local appearances in the future close to his home in California. This CD, "The Sun Is Shining Down" starts out with the uptempo "Hungry and Ready", a track that would make even a mangy old stray dog wag it's tail. The song features a great horn section and some wicked guitar licks by guest musician Melvin Taylor, who also plays on "Driving Wheel"-a track that also features some amazing horns, but this one has more of a 'blues on the down low' vibe. Another guest musician here is 26 year old Marcus



King who bends the strings and works the frets as he wails away on the magnificent "Can't Take No More". As for some of the other tracks, Mike Campbell of Tom Petty & the Heartbreakers brings a funky infused groove on the blues rocking track "Chills and Thrills" and Nashville guitarist Buddy Miller slides in on the sizzling low-end song "I'm As Good As Gone". There's a real nice change of pace courtesy of violin player Scarlet Rivera on "Got To Find A Better Way" as John's reserved vocals take the song to a new level. Scarlet is also featured on the number "Deep Blue Sea". Without describing every song here suffice it to say that when the album's namesake song closes off the collection (featuring Texas guitarist Carolyn Wonderland) the listener has taken a sonic journey that only John and company could provide.



TAX TIPS

SMALL BUSINESS TAX ADVICE

CANADA EMERGENCY BUSINESS ACCOUNT (CEBA) INTEREST-FREE LOANS

The CEBA has been expanded to offer small businesses and not-for-profit organizations an additional interest-free loan of up to \$20,000 on top of the \$40,000 already available. Businesses can have 50% of their new loan forgiven if they repay on or before December 31st, 2022. This is in addition to having up to 25% (up to \$10,000) of their original loan forgiven if it is repaid by the same date.

The portion of your CEBA loan that's forgiven is considered business income. However, you can choose to report this income on your return the year you received the loan, or the year you used it to pay for your business expenses. For example, you might report this income on next year's return if that's when you're also deducting your expenses, to lower your total taxable income. Businesses can apply for CEBA through their banks or credit unions. The deadline to apply for this loan was June 30, 2021.

Canada Emergency Rent Subsidy (CERS)

The Canada Emergency Rent Subsidy (CERS) replaced the Canada Emergency Commercial Rent Assistance (CECRA) Program, and no longer requires your landlord to participate.

The CERS provides rent and mortgage support directly to businesses and other organizations, offering a percentage of their eligible expenses based on how they've been affected by COVID-19, until October 23rd, 2021. Between August 29 and September 25, 2021, you can claim 40% of your expenses. Between September 25 and October 23, 2021, you can claim 20% of your expenses. Organizations that are temporarily closed because of a local public health decision can qualify for an additional 25% of their expenses. This support can also be claimed retroactively for prior periods. You'll need to report the subsidy you received as business income on your return, but this will be offset by the amount you claim for your business expenses.
