



So, what's in a name? Well, some mega-successful names like Haagen-Dazs, IKEA and Google are completely made-up with no real meaning, but if you're a traditional folk band from the east coast of Newfoundland I'd say that "Rugged Shores" is a prefect name. The band has been together for over 10 years now and this is their latest CD, "Wild River". They are well-known for the lively party atmosphere that they bring to the stage, which also carries over onto this CD. Rugged Shores consists of Rowan Sherlock on violin, Evan AuCoin on guitar, mandolin and vocals, Jim Feehan on guitar & vocals, Jeff Kinsman on bass guitar and Bryan Efford on drums. The CD starts out with the album's namesake song and what a song it iswith great instrumentation that lifts the uptempo number to great heights. To be honest though I was expecting an album that would be similar to Great Big Sea or Shanneyganock, but I heard a sound more akin to Ron Hvnes or the Irish Descendants-a fact borne out by the amazing songs "Woman" and "Far Away Light". As for some of the other songs, "Old St. John's"



and "One More Time" are more traditional footstomping toe tapping numbers, and "Outport Town" is a song that stands out so much for it's pure folk roots feel-again as if it was penned by Ron Hynes. It's very refreshing to hear an album from an east coast band that's not iust another cookie-cutter. "pour the Guinness and the bodhran" collection, plus the majority of the songs here are original compositions, fantastic ones at that. The album closes off with the hauntingly beautiful and sorrowful "Spancill Hill" written by Michael Considine; all the places and people mentioned in the lyrics are real. As Considine wrote the lyrics he knew that he'd never see his hometown of Spancill Hill, in County Claire, Ireland again; he passed away in 1873 at the tender age of 23 in California. # TAX TIPS

# TAX TIPS FOR SENIORS

- 1. Make sure they file a tax return Sounds simple, but some folks think that if they didn't earn an income, they shouldn't file a return. Filing always makes sense, because they could be entitled to other credits, deductions and benefits that get triggered once they file a tax return. For example, they'd need to file to receive the Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS) and filing late could interrupt the GIS benefit, GST/HST credits and other automatic benefits.
- 2. Split pension income Seniors are allowed to split up to half of their eligible pension income with a spouse or common-law partner, so they can assign a portion of what they earned throughout the year to their better half. This can mean a significant tax reduction when one spouse has very little income, and the other has a lot. Another way to reduce taxes is through transfer amounts. If one parent is unable to completely offset their age amount, pension income and disability amount against their taxes payable, they can transfer the unused portion to their spouse's return.
- 3. Claim medical expenses A portion of most medical expenses can be claimed! If your parent is part of a couple and the spouse with the lower income owes any tax, it usually makes the most sense for that person to claim them. Are your parents globetrotters? If they travelled to another country and purchased medical insurance for the trip, it's considered a medical expense. If they traveled to obtain medical treatment that wasn't available where they live, they might be able to claim the cost of transportation, meals and accommodation, depending on how far they needed to go.
- **4. Claim the caregiver amount** If your parent (or parents) are dependent on you by reason of mental or physical infirmity you may be eligible to claim the Canada caregiver amount. You will need a note from their doctor describing their condition. The Canada caregiver amount is worth \$6,986 less their net income in excess of \$16,405. This means that the amount is reduced to zero if their income is in excess of \$23,391.
- **5. Split the disability tax credit** If your parent qualifies for the Disability Tax Credit but doesn't have enough taxable income to take full advantage of it, they might be able to transfer an unused amount to you. In order to qualify for this, your parent must depend on you for all or some of the basic necessities of life.




