Brad Tuck is the drummer for the legendary Newfoundland band Shanneyganock; the St. John's resident has been a well-known part of the Newfoundland music scene for some time, and he also has a solo career with this being his third album release (he also released an EP in 2020). Now I'm 64", a song that around these parts is linked to Harry Hibbs, with it's lilting Irish influence that makes the song so beautiful. And speaking if the Emerald Isle, Brad's original composition "Irish All Along" makes those of us who have shamrocks and shillelaghs in our bloodstream count our blessings, and party on. Also, "The Ferryman" (aka "The Strawberry Beds") was written by Pete St. John and honours the River Liffey and Dublin. The CD closes off with a song whose origin dates back to 1851 and is mostly associated with Stan Rogers as "Three Fishers" is a lament to the many souls lost to the deep blue sea, and the families who mourn. Brad's cover is amazing, just like this CD is. You can find Brad's music on Spotify, Apple Music, and on Facebook. There are also some great videos on YouTube as well so check him out!

It's Tax Season once again and we will be running our weekly "TAX TIPS" column to help you prepare your Tax Return for 2021 and maximize the deductions you can claim especially this year with COVID programs - page 6 for details.

TAX TIPS

COVID TIPS FOR SENIORS

New extra payment for Old Age Security (OAS) - Back in June 2021, eligible seniors (those born on or after June 30, 1947) received a one-time OAS extra payment of \$500 as long as they met the age requirement. Since then, there is an additional extra payment. This one-time payment is taxable, but it was not subject to clawback.

Since this new bonus payment is not subject to clawback, this means that, if you make above a certain net income, you won't be subject to the 15% OAS recovery tax that is usually applied. This extra payment will be reported in a new box in the T4A slip instead of being included with the regular OAS benefits. It is also not included in your income when it comes to determining eligibility for the Guaranteed Income Supplement (GIS) - Allowance.

For more information about OAS and GIS payments, check out our Help Article for more details! Need help filing? Reach out to one of your local H&R Block tax experts today!

Increase in permanent payments - Effective July 2022, OAS payments will be permanently increased by 10% for seniors 75 or older. This means that eligible seniors can now receive an increase of \$770.70 per year, which is higher than the previous \$642.25 in past years. This is the first permanent increase to the OAS pension since 1973!

Reduced GIS payments due to CERB - Many seniors who received the GIS and got CERB back in 2020 got a shock when their benefit entitlement was reduced in July 2021 because of the additional income. Seniors who applied for CERB through Service Canada, can apply to have their GIS benefit recalculated based on their current employment, self-employment, or pension income. But it is worth noting that this re-calculation option isn't available to those who applied through the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA). This is because EI benefits - but not COVID-19 benefits - are defined as "pension" for this arrangement.

Back in December of 2021, the government announced it would make a one-time payment to help GIS recipients compensate for this financial hardship. July 2022 payments and COVID-19 benefits will also be excluded from the GIS calculation.

I watched the **Queen's Jubilee** ceremonies on TV last week and I was reminded of her visit to Sydney when I was a very young boy - I remember all the houses on **Whitney Avenue** in Sydney were draped with bunting and flags and all the people were lined up along the street to greet the Queen - There were fire trucks, police cars and limousines and lots of flags - it made quite an impression on me at the time - I waved, like everybody else, when the **Queen's vehicle** passed and I thought at the time that the Queen was actually looking at me as I waved. *Here's a little of the official program itinerary at the time HM Queen Elizabeth II and Prince Philip toured every Canadian province in 1959, visiting Nova Scotia on 31 July and 1 August. I wonder if she **remembers me** waving at her on Whitney Avenue????
