This week's column is about something that's absolutely rotten! To be more precise, Johnny Rotten and his partners in crime known as the Sex Pistols. This year marks 45 years since the release of the band's only album, and "Never Mind The Bollocks Here's the Sex Pistols" is one of the most influential albums in music history. How can I say that? Well, the album featured the song "God Save The Queen" which holds the record (no pun intended) for being the most banned song in U.K. history. Plus, the song led to rioting in the streets, violent attacks on the band members, and public outrage the likes of which Britain had never seen before. The album and the band's chaotic live performances also blew up the whole punk rock movement-giving it the collective kick up the arse it needed to fan the flames of anarchy and dissent, and inspired countless musicians and bands that went on to great success and fame long after the Pistols imploded. When the single "God Save The Queen" was released the number 1 song on the charts at the time was Rod Stewart's "I Don't Want To Talk About It". However, the Sex Pistols were kicking Rod the Mod's butt in sales,

yet their song was blocked from scoring the welldeserved number 1 spot, as many conspired and colluded to censor and suppress that success, fearful that it would inflame more dissent, and the establishment couldn't let those 'degenerate punkers' become even more famous than they were. We all know how that backfired! The album itself did finally get the number 1 spot on the U.K. charts and has been described by learned musicologists as the most important punk album ever made. The Sex Pistols were indeed created by the Svengali-like shyster Malcolm McLaren, who was influenced Americans the Ramones. the New York Dolls (who he managed for a time) and Richard Hell. The fact that half of the Pistols had dubious musical skills didn't matter-it was all about the look, the shock factor and that somebody had to rage against conformity, all that gave us a legendary band and a legendary album.


