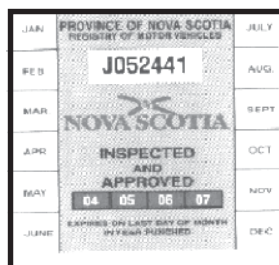

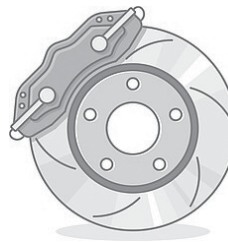

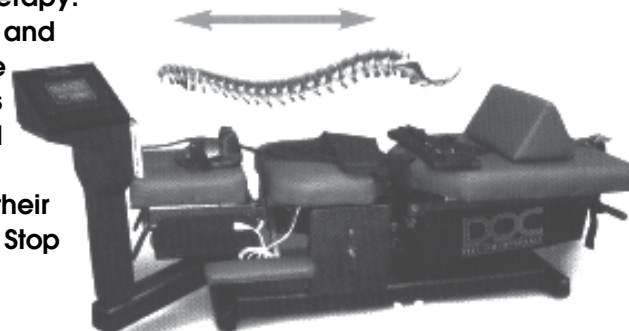

Sass Jordan is definitely a musical force to reckon with; her first album released back in 1988 earned a Juno award, with the hit single "Tell Somebody" and 1992's hit single "Make You A Believer" firmly established Sass as a real rocker. But if you listened closely you could hear some blues influence working its way into her music, until it eventually became the dominant sound. This, "**Bitches Blues**", is her latest album and what an album it is. Everything kicks off with killer track "Still Alive And Well", which is the most rock-oriented song in the mix and lets us all know her status. The very cool "Chevrolet" is helped out by some wicked harmonica and slide guitar, and "You Gotta Move" walks a winding path all the way down to the bayou, but "Sailin' Shoes" is the real surprise here-with its uptempo honky tonk piano groove and funky undercurrent that makes the track stand out so much. That strong piano also shows up on the minimal "Even", with only those keys and a bass backing up Sass's amazing vocals. As



for some of the other songs, "Still The World Goes Round" has a real sing-along vibe that grabs the listener and makes them want to march along to the message it carries, as Sass sings "People gotta stand up. People gotta shout. People, take your power back cuz that's your ticket out." The song "Change Is Coming" finishes things and it has a bit of a Melissa Etheridge feel to it, plus it was a great choice to close out the set. Sass was joined here by the "The Champagne Hookers"; guitarists Chris Caddell and Jimmy Reid, Cass Pereira on drums, keyboardist Jesse O'Brien, and Steve Marriner on bass and harmonica. Granted, there are only 8 songs here (with 2 being originals) but that's neither here nor there, as this entire collection is a great sonic experience.

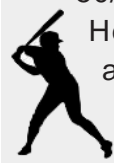

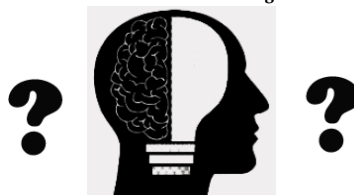
