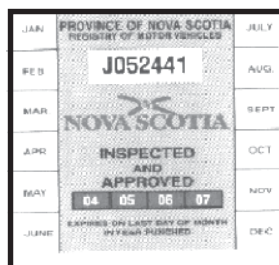

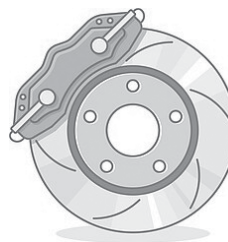

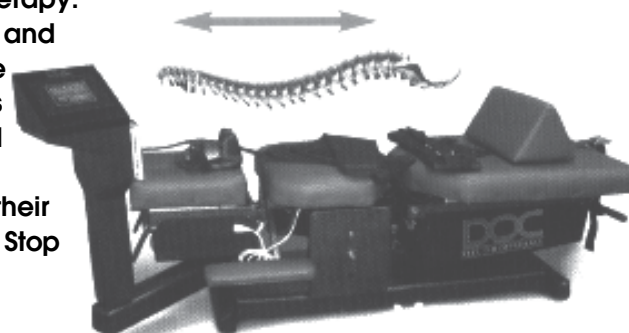

I watched this documentary a number of years ago, and to this day it is one of the most unusual that I have ever seen; "**Marwencol**" chronicles the life of Mark Hogancamp, who was attacked by 5 men in 2010 outside a bar in New York, and they nearly beat him to death. Mark spent 9 days in a coma and another 40 days in the hospital, but was discharged because he couldn't pay for the therapy. He had no memories of his previous life before the attack (he was a married navy man and an alcoholic) but found another life, and another world in the tiny town (literally) of Marwencol. Mark created the entire town in a one-sixth scale World War II Belgian town design, complete with inhabitants (think 12 inch G.I. Joe's and Jane's) and story lines for each figure; a number of them look like his family and friends. For fans of military modelling and action figures (like myself) this film is a treat to watch; the detail in everything is amazing. The documentary opens up with a photo collage of Mark's handiwork-and at first the majority of the shots look like living persons in outdoor settings. However, as the film progresses things get a bit



darker, as Mark talks in-depth about the "inhabitants", their personal lives, and his own figure-including it's violent torture by the SS, and his rescue by a number of 'resistance maidens'. This is where you can see how the imaginary world of Marwencol saved Mark's life, even if the whole notion flies in the face of conventionality, and to a certain degree-sanity. To show just how unique and captivating this documentary is, actor Steve Carell eventually played Mark in the big ticket movie "Welcome to Marwen", which also included an all-star cast of Leslie Mann, Diane Kruger, Gwendoline Christie and Janelle Monae, to name just a few. This doc is a great example of fantasy vs reality, and how one man chose to save his life with fantasy.

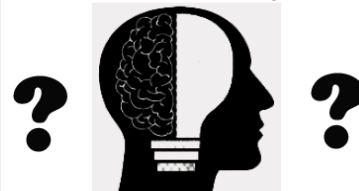
