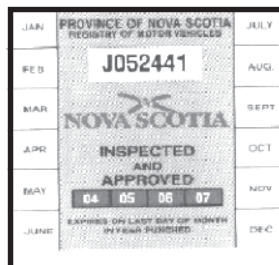

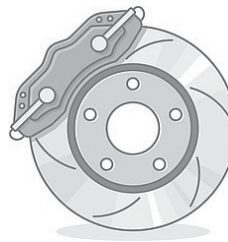

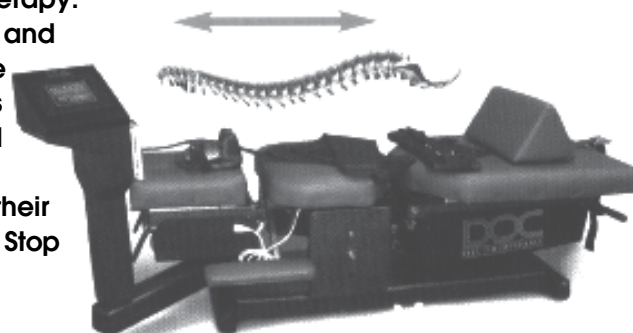

"Some Guys" may very well be the best 'covers' album I've ever heard. Even at an early age American musician Jonathan Coulton was hooked on music; he did the conventional artist thing, but that grind got to him and he moved into building computer databases, in his spare time continuing to write songs-ones that were mostly tech based, so he was asked to perform at a tech conference. The rest is history. Coulton found a way to go directly to his fans with his music, to quote his website "he even adopted the Creative Commons: shared art, uploaded online, liberated from traditional copyright. When Coulton walked out into the cold Maine sunshine, he remembers, it was like my head was on fire. I was like, holy shit, something is happening!" Suddenly, anyone could publish music. Between HTML, MP3s, and Paypal, you could build your own label. Podcasts were radio shows. The internet had just begun to blink fully awake, but already it was a tangle of creativity, turning strangers into a community." So, over a dozen albums later we have this one (yes, a play on the Rolling Stones "Some Girls" album). I love the music of the 1970's and Jonathan's covers here are amazing. The album starts off



with the America song "Sister Golden Hair" and it's the best take I've ever heard-next to the original. If that perfection wasn't enough, Coulter's cover of "Wildfire" (by Michael Martin Murphy) is absolutely stunning-this is a 'must-hear' song. In the 1970's the hit maker Gilbert O'Sullivan had quirky songs. They were uptempo numbers melody-wise, but carried a deeper sadness that belied the melody. Jonathan's version of "Alone Again (Naturally)" here is perfect. To continue, Bread's "Make It With You", the Bee Gees "How Deep Is Your Love" and "If You Could Read My Mind" by Gordon Lightfoot all get the royal treatment in this collection. Fittingly, the album finishes off with a perfect version of Dan Fogelberg's hit song "Same Old Lang Syne"; it's a song of remembrance, things held, things lost-and how you can never go back to the old days. The 14 songs in this collection are pure diamonds-all placed in a golden setting.

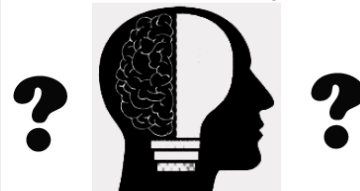
