

# IMPORTANT DATES TAX DATES

There are several important dates this Tax Season. Here is a list of the big dates:

Today - Canada Pension & Old Age Security slips available through CRA online now

Feb 1 - T4E slips for Employment Insurance should be available through Service Canada online

Feb 21 - CRA EFILE opens - first day to transmit returns through the EFILE online system

**Feb 28** - T4 slips must be distributed by employers by end of day

Feb 28 - T3, T5, T4A & T5008 slips distributed in most cases

Mar 1 - RRSP contribution deadline for 2021 tax use

Apr 30 - Tax payments are due, even if you have not filed yet - so interest will accumulate after this date


May 2 - Personal taxes filing deadline - The annual date is normally April 30th, but that falls on a weekend this year, so we get a couple of extra days to file!

Jun 15 - Self-Employed tax filing deadline for those filing a T2125 Statement of Business, as well as their spouse or common law partner...
